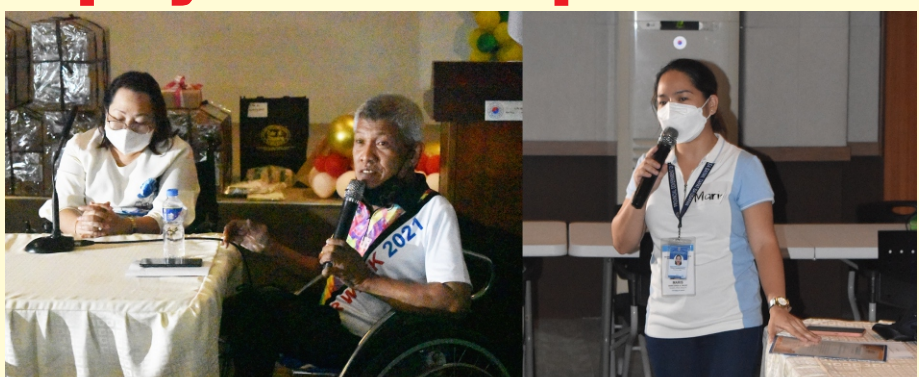

Deployment of computer sets to local government units of Cavite



The Provincial Persons with Disability Affairs Office headed by Ms. Marie Shiela Haloc in partnership with the National Council of Disability Affairs (NCDA) carried a ceremonial turnover program of complete sets of computer to some local government units of the province on October 13, 2022 at Cavite Collaboration Center for Public Health, Trece Martires City.

Local government units of Alfonso, Amadeo, Dasmariñas City, General Trias City, General Mariano Alvarez, Kawit, Magallanes, Silang, Tanza, and Trece Martires City received the computer sets which are intended to use for the real-time encoding of PWD data in the Department of Health – Philippine Registry with Disabilities (PRPWD) system.

Through the PRPWD database, all PWDs in the province would be identified and verified quickly and could apply for the privileges and incentives from the government. BOC-NAIA Coll. Talusan record breaking on collection and apprehension!

The Bureau of Customs has cited the revenue collection district of the Ninoy Aquino International Airport [NAIA] District Collector Carmelita Talusan for its record breaking-achievement on collection and apprehension. The Port of NAIA Coll. Talusan surpassed its P24.61 billion revenue target for the first eight months of this year (January to August) by more than P1.82 billion when it collected a total of P26.43 billion.

According to Coll. Talusan last year, it collected a total of P38.9 billion in duties and taxes and was able to hit its targets since 2011. The Customs agents at the airport also seized a total of P253 million worth of smuggled drugs and other prohibited substances from January to September. The contrabands included ecstasy, ketamine, kush, liquid marijuana, and shabu.

Customs Commissioner Yogi Filemon L. Ruiz commended NAIA collector Carmelita Talusan and her men during the port's 62nd anniversary with the theme "Soaring Towards A Digitized, Transparent and Excellent Public Service." The occasion highlighted the other accomplishments of NAIA port, which include the seizure of smuggled shipment of illegal drugs worth P1.6 billion in Cabanatuan City in October 2020, the biggest controlled delivery operation in the history of drug law enforcement in the country.

Co. Ruiz also expressed his gratitude to Customs NAIA officials and personnel for facilitating the immediate release of more than 240.9 million doses of COVID-19 vaccines and PPEs (personal protective equipment). Com. Ruiz said "At this point, I would like to convey my thanks to you, Collector Mimel Talusan for your aggressive initiatives and relentless efforts which made it possible for us, Customs employees, and our families to receive the vaccines and boosters in the comfort of our premises. BOC-Com. Ruiz Seizes over P228-M worth of Imported Sugar without SRA clearance!

THE Bureau of Customs [BOC] now under Acting Commissioner Yogi Filemon L. Ruiz seized P228-million worth of imported refined cane Sugar after arriving in the country without the required import clearances from the Sugar Regulatory Administration (SRA).

In a statement on Monday from BOC, Customs Intelligence and Investigation Service (CIIS) Director and Intelligence Group officer-in-charge Jeffroy Tacio said the agency already received intelligence reports about the shipment that allegedly contained "misdeclared and underdeclared items."

After receiving this information, BOC issued an Alert Order last October 4. The Manila International Container Port (CIIS-MICP) chief IO-3 Alvin Y. Enciso said that there was an attempt by the consignee, or the receiver of the shipment, to change its name last October 10, after the issuance of an alert order.

Dir. Tacio said "There were already initial information about the shipment's status. What's good is all of us here acted expeditiously upon receiving this information from high authorities."

The sugar was said to have been sourced from Thailand, and arrived at the Manila port on September 24. However, it did not carry the required SRA documents.

The BOC issued Two [2] Warrants of Seizure and Detention (WSD) for not having the clearance for release of imported sugar from SRA, and for violating Sections 117 and 1113 of the Republic Act No. 10863 or the Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA).

Commissioner Yogi Filemon L. Ruiz himself inspected the 76 containers that contained the sugar. Com. Ruiz said he is proud of what the team has achieved as the offices did not allow the names of the consignees to be changed.

Com. Ruiz said "There is a lot of 'HOCUS POCUS' that these smugglers try to get away with their crimes. We aren't just here looking for every hoarder and smuggler. We're here to stop any action that would jeopardize our market prices, the local production, and the impact of these on our workers and consumers." **turn to page 5**

Zambo Customs Coll. Atty. Barte Jr. seized P500-M Smuggled Cigarettes!

The Bureau of Customs [BOC] Port of Zamboanga Customs District Collector Atty. Segundo Sigmundfreud Z. Barte Jr. seized almost P500 million worth of smuggled cigarettes for the past 10 months [Jan. to Oct.] in Zamboanga Peninsula and the Muslim provinces of Basilan, Sulu and Tawi-Tawi.

Coll. Atty. Barte Jr. said that P449.713 million worth of assorted cigarettes were confiscated in various anti-smuggling operations in collaboration with security forces in the region.

Coll. Atty. Barte Jr. said in the first two weeks of this month, anti-smuggling operations netted 5,358 boxes of undocumented cigarettes worth P187.5 million. On the BOC records, P31,706,500 in May; P45,210,200 in June; P21,428,400 in July; P26,057,500 in August; and P32,234,300 in September.

According to Coll. Atty. Barte Jr. they collected P8.6 billion in revenues as of October 14 and may likely reach its target of P10 billion by the end of the year.

The intensified operations of the Zamboanga Customs under Coll. Atty. Segundo Barte Jr. did not say how many people had been charged in court. It also did not say who were behind the unabated smuggling of contraband in the region. **[A.J]**

BOC-Com. Ruiz Seizes P228-M worth of Imported Sugar without SRA clearance

THE Bureau of Customs [BOC] now under Acting Commissioner Yogi Filemon L. Ruiz seized P228-million worth of imported refined cane sugar after arriving in the country without the required import clearances from the Sugar Regulatory Administration (SRA).

In a statement on Monday from BOC, Customs Intelligence and Investigation Service (CIIS) Director and Intelligence Group officer-in-charge Jeoffrey Tacio said the agency already received intelligence reports about the shipment that allegedly contained "misdeclared and underdeclared items."

After receiving this information, BOC issued an Alert Order last October 4.

The Manila International Container Port (CIIS-MICP) chief IO-3 Alvin Y. Enciso said that there was an attempt by the consignee, or the receiver of the shipment, to change its name last October 10, after the issuance of an alert order.

Dir. Tacio said "There were already initial information about the shipment's status. What's good is all of us here acted expeditiously upon receiving this information from high authorities."

The sugar was said to have been sourced from Thailand, and arrived at the Manila port on September 24. However, it did not carry the required SRA documents.

The BOC issued Two [2] Warrants of Seizure and Detention (WSD) for not having the clearance for release of imported sugar from SRA, and for violating Sections 117 and 1113 of the Republic Act No. 10863 or the Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA).

Commissioner Yogi Filemon L. Ruiz himself inspected the 76 containers that contained the sugar.

Com. Ruiz said he is proud of what the team has achieved as the officers did not allow the names of the consignees to be changed.

Com. Ruiz said "There is a lot of 'HOCUS POCUS' that these smugglers try to get away with their crimes. We aren't just here looking for

every hoarder and smuggler. We're here to stop any action that would jeopardize our market prices, the local production, and the impact of these on our workers and consumers."

"I'm proud of what our team has done in this case. They didn't let this attempt to change consignees go through and were fast on their feet in making sure we stop another shipment from entering our local markets," he added.

This is not the first time that BOC stopped sugar shipments from entering the country over speculations of smuggling. Last August, it was reported that a cargo vessel carrying at least 7,000 metric tons of sugar was stopped at the Subic Bay Freeport for using recycled importation permits.

Six [6] Customs officials were relieved while a probe on the incident was underway.

Last September, BOC also seized P1.8 billion worth of imported goods and sugar in Batangas — including 181,299 sacks of pure refined sugar also from Thailand.

The BOC's operations came after President Ferdinand Marcos Jr. himself called on the bureau to get to the bottom of alleged sugar smuggling and hoarding in the country. Malacañang said hoarders are setting up an 'artificial shortage' in the country.

Prior to that, Pres. Marcos voided SRA's Sugar Order No. 4 as the document allows the importation of 300,000 metric tons of sugar to address an impending shortage and increasing sugar prices. Pres. Marcos however said that the country only needs to import lower than 300,000 metric tons of sugar.

Eventually, Pres. Marcos allowed sugar importation, but only for 150,000 metric tons — with the provision that half of the supply would go to industrial users while the other half would be intended for the market or consumers.

The Panels in both the House of Representatives and the Senate have launched investigation into the issue, with the Senate minority bloc saying that former executive secretary Vic Rodriguez — who gave SRA the order to draft a sugar importation order.

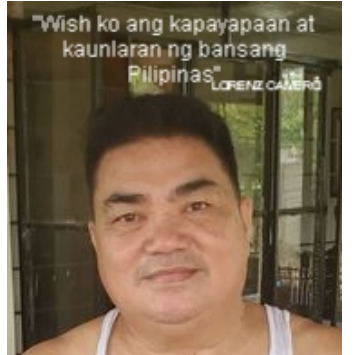

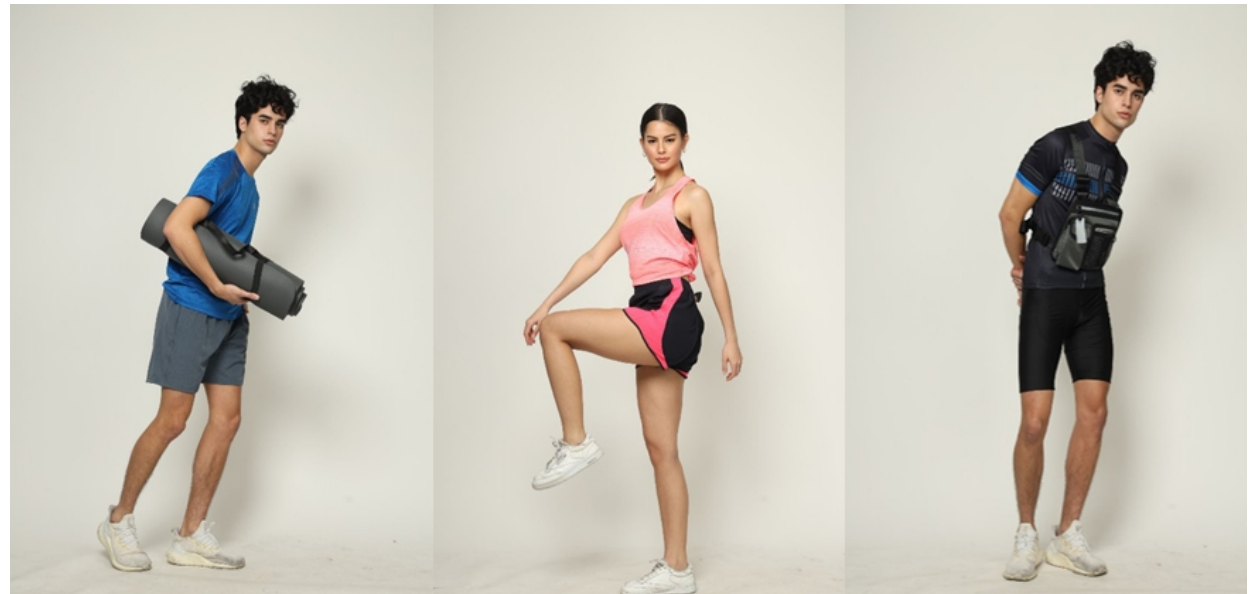

Disposal of valueless office records

The Provincial Government of Cavite properly disposed various valueless office records and documents that have reached the records disposition schedule on October 11, 2022 at the General Services Office, Provincial Capitol Compound, Trece Martires City.

The actual disposal is in compliance with Republic Act No. 9470, otherwise known as the



"National Archives Act of 2007," which aims to strengthen the system of management and administration of archival records, establishing for the purpose the National Archives of the Philippines (NAP), and strictly follows the applicable rules and regulations of NAP General Circular No. 2, Guidelines on the Disposal of Valueless Records in Government Agencies, dated January 20, 2009.

A total of 2,478 kilos of office documents and records from the General Services Office, Bids and Awards Committee, Human Resource Management Office and Provincial Budget Office were approved for disposal and sold to D' Lacoste Enterprises, the NAP accredited disposal partner. Proceeds was forwarded to the Provincial Treasurer's Office and will serve as general fund for different local government programs.

The activity was witnessed by NAP representative Wendy H. Sacramed, Commission on Audit representative Angelita A. Matel, GSO Head and Chair of the Records Management Improvement Committee (RMIC) Ferdinand V. Belamide, and PGC representative. (PICAD)

"I'm proud of what our team has done in this case. They didn't let this attempt to change consignees go through and were fast on their feet in making sure we stop another shipment from entering our local markets," he added.

This is not the first time that BOC stopped sugar shipments from entering the country over speculations of smuggling. Last August, it was reported that a cargo vessel carrying at least 7,000 metric tons of sugar was stopped at the Subic Bay Freeport for using recycled importation permits.

At least six Customs officials were relieved while a probe on the incident was underway.

Last September, BOC also seized P1.8 billion worth of imported goods and sugar in Batangas — including 181,299 sacks of pure refined sugar also from Thailand.

The BOC's operations came after President Ferdinand Marcos Jr. himself called on the bureau to get to the bottom of alleged sugar smuggling and hoarding in the country.

Malacañang said hoarders are setting up an 'artificial shortage' in the country.

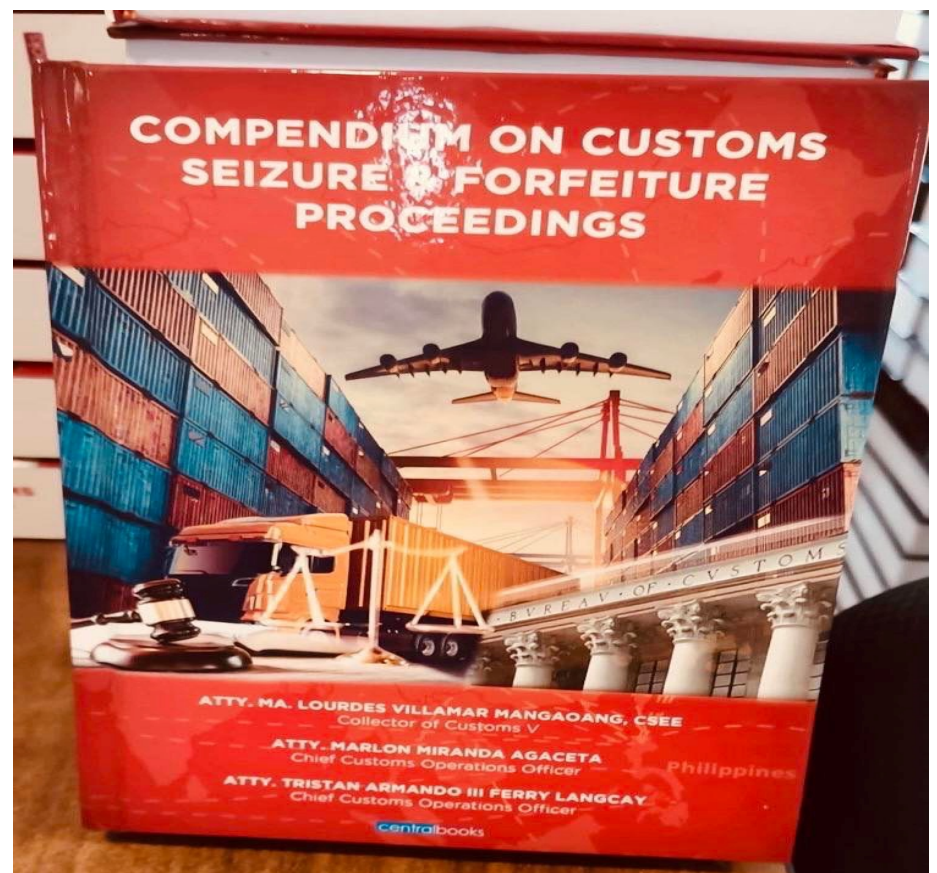
Prior to that, Pres. Marcos voided SRA's Sugar Order No. 4 as the document allows the importation of 300,000 metric tons of sugar to address an impending shortage and increasing sugar prices. Pres. Marcos however said that the country only needs to import lower than 300,000 metric tons of sugar.

Eventually, Pres. Marcos allowed sugar importation, but only for 150,000 metric tons — with the provision that half of the supply would go to industrial users while the other half would be intended for the market or consumers.

The Panels in both the House of Representatives and the Senate have launched investigation into the issue, with the Senate minority bloc saying that former executive secretary Vic Rodriguez — who gave SRA the order to draft a sugar importation order — cannot be blameless. [J.G]
