Appeal for the release of 2 Cebu-based BPO Execs

Innocentrix Philippines, family members and friends has called on the Philippines Government to assist the release from detention of two Cebu-based Business Processing Outsourcing (BPO) executives, who were allegedly involved in defrauding elderly authors in the United States.

These two executives were Michael Sordilla, the founder of Hyias Philippines and CEO of Innocentrix Philippines and Bryan Tarosa, Innocentrix Vice President for operations. Lawyer Oliver Baclay Jr., spokesperson for Sordilla and Tarosa in a press conference has called on President Ferdinand Marcos Jr. and the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA) to assist the immediate release of the two from detention in the United States.

MCIA welcomes new direct Cebu-Ho Chi Minh flights

Mactan Cebu International Airport (MCIA) has welcomed a new international flight from Cebu to Ho Chi Minh City (Saigon) which took off starting 7 April 2025.

This marks the first-ever direct air link between Central Visayas and Vietnam, boosting regional connectivity, and fostering stronger economic and cultural ties between the two regions.

"We are thrilled to welcome Cebu Pacific's new Cebu-Ho Chi Minh route," said Aboitiz InfraCapital Cebu Airport Corporation (AICAC), Chief Executive Officer for MCIA Athanasios Titonis. "This milestone underscores MCIA's commitment to expanding our international network and solidifying Cebu's position as a key hub in Southeast Asia. We look forward to strengthening ties between the Philippines and Vietnam through enhanced air connectivity."

Dr. Debra Maria Catulong, head of Mandaue City Health Office (MCHO) announced on Thursday that the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) has completed the pre-procurement phase and is awaiting approval from the City Engineering Office to commence construction.

She added that they aim to start construction this year, as it is also the deadline set by the Department of Health (DOH).

Fake news vloggers face cybercrime raps

The Police Regional Office in Central Visayas (PRO-7) filed on April 4, 2025 cybercrime charges against two individuals for allegedly spread fake news through their social media accounts.

PRO-7 Regional Director Brig. Gen. Redrico Maranan said the cases stemmed from a manipulated video of a procession related to Fiesta Senor and presented it as a prayer rally supporting former President Rodrigo Duterte after his arrest.

Formally charged were Leocimar Magallanes and Salic Daurong under the Cybercrime Prevention Act of 2012 after police

However, those gadgets raised suspicions among authorities, who they claimed that it is being used for scamming which resulted into their arrest.

The Calamba City Health Office located in Brgy. VII, Calamba City and Cuba Urban Health Center located in Brgy. Punta, Calamba City are now accredited as the First Dental Clinics nationwide to provide the preventive oral health services in primary care.

Through its Accreditation and Quality Assurance Section (AQAS) and Local Health Insurance (LHIO) Calamba City, PhilHealth Regional Office IV-A (PRO IV-A) has facilitated the accreditation of the said facilities with a validity period from February 18, 2025 to December 31, 2025.

This initiative ensures that members and their qualified dependents can avail themselves of routine preventive oral care. This provision includes mandatory services such as:

- * mouth examination or oral screenings
- * dental prophylaxis (cleaning)
- * fluoride varnish application

On the other hand, the pit and fissure sealant application or root surface protection/Class V restoration (limited to two teeth per year) and emergency tooth extractions can be availed as applicable only.

PhilHealth beneficiaries can avail themselves of the Preventive Oral Health Services through the Konsulta Package Provider (KPP) where they are registered.

The KPPs that are direct service providers will provide oral health services to their PhilHealth Konsulta clients within their catchment population through their own dental/oral health service or clinic. On the other hand, KPPs that are referring facilities shall assign and refer their clients to their affiliate PhilHealth-accredited primary dental care clinics for the provision of oral health services.

More dental clinics are anticipated to be accredited to provide preventive oral health services so that patients can easily and conveniently avail it. **#RFV**
