

MPT South's "ALERTO KADA KILOMETRO" Drayberks Road Safety Seminar conducted at PITX

DA implements prolonged deadline for imported rice

Department of Agriculture (DA) Secretary Francisco Tiu Laurel Jr. has extended the must-ship-out date for imported rice to 60 days from 30 days. This will allow local importers to "shop around and get better rates" for freight costs.

Tiu-Laurel explained that freight companies have increased rates on local rice importers due to the earlier 30-day deadline for rice imports to arrive in the country. The must ship-out date stipulates the deadline that an allowed rice import must enter the country which started on the day that the shipment's sanitary and Phytosanitary Import clearance (SPSIC) was issued.

Tiu Laurel cited to make it 60 days as this will protect local farmers and the need to ensure food security.

POGO confirmed in Lapu-Lapu City as PAOCC-NBI raids hotel

The Presidential Anti-Organized Crime Commission NO (PAOCC), National Bureau of Investigation (NBI), the Bureau of Immigration (BI), Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), and Inter-Agency Council Against Trafficking (IACAT) confirmed that a Philippine Offshore Gaming Operators (POGO) was operating at the Tourist Garden Hotel in Barangay Agus, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu on 31 August 2024. PAOCC spokesperson Winston Casio said three scam farms were found in three buildings in the hotel.

"Yes, this is 100 percent an illegal POGO.. illegal po Ito Kasi wala pong POGO may lisanya SA Cebu province, Lahat Ng nakakita namin dito enough evidence cyber-crime offense for facilitating cyber crime gambling," Casio said.

The Presidential Anti-Organized Crime Commission (PAOCC) and National Bureau of Investigation (NBI) on 6 September found an identification card(ID) allegedly issued by the Lapu-Lapu City Government of being a City Consultant.

The ID showed Shouqi Zhao, who operates the Tourist Garden Hotel in Barangay Agus, was a consultant for Chinese Business Promotions under the Office of the Mayor of Lapu-Lapu City.

Mandaue Mayor files motion on 1-year suspension

Mandaue City Mayor Jonas Cortes on 29 August 2024 has filed a motion for reconsideration before the Office of the Ombudsman on his one year suspension.

Mandaue City Administrator Lawyer Jamaal James Calipayan told DAILY TRIBUNE that the MR was filed at the Office of the Ombudsman in Quezon City.

He said that Cortes was given 10 days to file his MR as his suspension order was served on 21 August.

The 10-day period will lapse on 2 September as 1 September falls on a Sunday. Cortes in his MR sought to dismiss the administrative case against him or at least a reduction of the

Rice Industry players both traders and importers have appealed to the Bureau of Plant Industry (BPI) to extend the must ship-out deadline after they faced cancellation of contracts by Vietnamese exporters, who were seeking better prices for their stocks.

BPI issues the SPSIC. Vietnam accounts for three-fourths of the country's annual rice imports.

Philippine Chamber of Agriculture and Food Inc.(PCAFI) president Danilo Fausto said some Vietnamese rice exporters are taking advantage of the government's decision to lower rice tariffs to 15 percent by increasing their export prices.

"I do not think it is the world market causing the increase in export prices but it is more on a profit motive," Fausto told reporters.

The Philippine Rice Industry Stakeholders Movement co-founder Orly Manuntag said rice export prices in the neighboring Southeast Asian country have increased by \$60 to \$70 per metric ton, which forced Vietnamese suppliers to call off contracts with Philippine importers.

International reports indicated that Vietnamese rice export prices have steadily increased in recent months on the back of foreseen higher global demand for the grain, especially in countries like Indonesia and the Philippines.

The price uptick happened few weeks after the

Philippines lowered the rice tariffs from 35 percent to 15 percent which took effect on 5 July 2024.

On the national scene, the DA said it may sell rice at P40 per kilo if prevailing retail market prices soften as soon as more imported rice slapped with lower tariff rate arrives in the country in the coming months.

"If the retail prices of rice in the market reach P45 per kilo, then our Rice-for-All program would be priced at P40 per kilo," Tiu Laurel said.

The Rice-for-All program, which started 1 August 2024, sells well-milled rice sourced from local importers and traders to the public at P45 per kilo, with a limit of 25 kilos per day, lower than prevailing prices between P47 to P55 per kilo.

Rice imports in the first half of 2024 averaged around 400,000 metric tons before dropping to an average arrival of 200,000MT in July and August.

internet-based scams, were seized inside the hotel.

Casio said that after receiving information from the central government regarding complaints from the Indonesian government, they immediately set the rescue operation in coordination with the Department of Justice (DOJ).

The POGO operation occupied three floors of the hotel, with bars and restaurants on the lower floor to keep workers from leaving the premises.

Oliva said the Lapu-Lapu City Prosecutor's Office was investigating the case of three Indonesian nationals who had escaped and filed a complaint against their employers on 21 July 2024, as they alleged that they were briefly illegally detained.

Earlier, Lapu-Lapu City Mayor Junard Chan said there was no POGO in the city. (By RICO MIRASOL OSMENA)

He added that those engaged in POGO operations in Pampanga, who had recently been raided without being charged, moved to Cebu to continue their fraudulent schemes.

"We are here to rescue the Indonesian nationals, but upon arrival, we caught them in flagrante delicto, in the act of running scam operations. We found three scam farms run by Chinese, Indonesian and Myanmar nationals," Casio disclosed.

The operatives broke into the hotel and discovered more than a hundred individuals, who were involved in various scams.

Computers, believed to be used in love scams and other

connection with his office, citing that IDs now can be easily replicated.

"We do not have a record that we hired Zhao as a consultant. As I said, we will not issue an ID if you are hired as a consultant, only the employees of the local government in Lapu-Lapu," Chan insisted.

This as the NBI-Cebu District Office disclosed that on 3 September, there were bundles of P1,000 cash were found inside a box when inventoried.

"This was inventoried in the presence of our Presidential

Organized Crime Commission and Bureau of Immigration and it turns out the total amount is P8 million," Arnel Pura, supervising agent, NBI-Cebu District Office.

It was supposed to be sneaked out by a Filipino employee of Zhao, along with rice and cooking oils.

In 2019 November, the Lapu-Lapu City government gave a "Special Token of Appreciation" to Shouqi Zhao alias Zhao Long, who then the president of the Lapu-Lapu City Chinese Guild for donating solar lamps and computers in a School in Barangay Pangan-an, Olango island. (By RICO MIRASOL OSMENA)

The Ombudsman suspended Mayor Cortes for one year without pay for grave misconduct.

Cortes was penalized for appointing Camilo Basaca Jr.

as officer-in-charge of the City Social Welfare Services Office (CSWSO) in 2022, with Basaca having lack of qualifications.

However, Cortes said that Basaca's appointment was in

good faith and was meant to improve the services at CSWSO.

The Ombudsman decision was penned and signed by Graft Investigation and Prosecution Officer Napoleon Regan Malimas as he cited that the penalty for grave misconduct was dismissal from service even on the first offense.

However, Malimas said that since there was "neither allegation nor was it found that the irregular designation of Basaca was attended with elements of corruption," the Ombudsman is only suspending Cortes for one year.

Cortes in an earlier interview clarified that there is no corruption issue in the case especially on using public funds. (By RICO MIRASOL OSMENA)

M agtatapos na ang dalawang termino ni Mayor Vico Sotto sa non-stop na pagbatikos sa sinasabi nyang mga korap at tiwaling namumuno noon sa lungsod, pero hanggang sa ngayon ay wala pa umano itong naipakukulang, o formal na nasampahan ng kaso sa Ombudsman o sa alinmang sangay ng hukuman.

Payahay ito ng bagong tatag na 'Tayo Pasigueño Movement,' isang sectoral org para sa tapat na serbisyo, bilang pagsusog at suportang reaksiyon sa panawagan sa social media ng mga residente na kailangang "ipakita ng punong-lungsod ang mga sinasabi nyang pagbabago hindi sa salita kundi sa gawa."

Sa Facebook page na Taga Pasig Kami ay hinikayat si Sotto na basahin ang 'open letter' na madamdaming nagpapaalaala sa alkalde na kailangan na nitong mag-move on, at ihinto na ang mga paninira sa nagdaang administrasyon.

Noong 2019 ay saka ka lang nag-ingay nang tatako kung mayor at siniraan mo lahat na nagdaang mayor, wala kung pinuri niisa na akala mo ay ikaw lang ang magaling at ang aming pag-asa," saad ni Jenifer De Leon sa kanyang open letter sa Facebook kay Sotto.

Maging ang kontrobersiyal na P9.6 bilyong City Hall complex ay ipinaalaala rin sa open letter na keysa magarborg projecto na pinundohan mula sa buwis ng Pasigueños ay dapat ang mga higit na pangangailangan ng nakararaming residente, lalo na ng maralitang sektor, ang nauhing inasisiko ng LGU 'tulad ng ospital at mga health centers na kompleto sa gamot at mga medical instruments.

SAginawang operasyon ng PNP ay matagumpay nilang nailigtas ang dalawang hinihinalang biktima ng trafficking.

Ang isa ay 21-anyos na lalaki mula sa Samar na bumagsak sa KOJC recruiter sa mga pangako ng pag-aaral sa Cebu na 3 taon na nitong Hindi nakakaugnayan ang pamilya.

Ang ikalawang biktima ay Isang 53-anyos na matandang babae mula sa Cotabato City na biglang naglaho umano sa loob ng compound ng KOJC.

Kapwa nagpahayag ang dalawang ito ng takot at kagustuhang umalis na sa compound.

Ibinunyag din ng dalawang na hindi NILA gustong manatili dito pagkat ginagamit lang sila sa operasyon ng KOJC.

Samantalang dalawang lamang biktima ang nailigtas sa operasyon ay naniniwala ang mga awtoridad na mayroon pang iba na nakakulung sa compound.

Si Quiboloy, ay kilalang kaalyado ni dating President Rodrigo Duterte, na matagal ng pinaghahanap ng batas sa kasong human trafficking, sex trafficking, child trafficking, at smuggling.

Simula ng imbestigasyon noong 2021 sa ilalim ng

Duterte administration ay lagging nakatatakas umano si Quiboloy sa batas.

Sinasabing malalim umano ang kunkasyon nina Duterte at Quiboloy na umano ginastusan ng pastor Si Duterte ng tumakbo itong presidente ng bansa.

Marami din ang nagsasabing Si Quiboloy ang sinasabing "spiritual advisor" at trusted confidante.

Napag-alaman din na habang nagtagtago si Quiboloy ay itinalaga niya si Duterte na administrator ng KOJC's assets.

At maliwanag din na si Duterte umano ay nalaman sa exploitation, abuse, at trafficking na nagaganap sa KOJC's at anomalya ni Quiboloy.

oOo COA sinita inaamag na nutribun, sablay na implementasyon ng feeding program ng DepEd sa ilalim ni VP Sara

Sinita ng Commission on Audit (COA) ang inaamag na nutribun, nabubulok na mga food item, hindi maayos na pagkakabalot ng mga pagkain at kuwestyunable manufacturing at expiration date ng mga pagkain sa ilalim ng school feeding program ng Department of Education (DepEd) noong 2023, sa ilalim ng pamumuno ni Vice President Sara Duterte.

Sa audit report ng COA para sa taong 2023, sinabi nito na 21 Schools Divisions Office sa iba't ibang bahagi ng bansa ang nakaraan ng delay o hindi na-deliver sa oras ang pagkain at gatas sa ilalim ng P5.69 bilyong School Based Feeding Program (SBFP) ng DepEd.

Ayon kay bagong DepEd Sec. Juan Edgardo Angara, may nikitang mga insektos sa loob Karabun/Milky bun and E-nutribun (squash) noong isagawa ng state auditors ng COA sa Aurora sa nasabing mga pagkain.

Sa Bulacan SDO, nalaman ng audit team na ang mga ipinadlangang pagkain ay bulok, hindi pa hinog, o nasira. Ang Bulacan at Aurora ay kapwa nasa Region 3 (Central Luzon).

Sa Metro Manila, inireklamo naman ng Quezon City SDO ang hindi magandang packaging at ang laman umano ay mas malito o mas magaan kumpara sa nakalagay sa kontrata.

Layunin ng SBFP na matulungan ang mga undernourished learner sa mga pampublikong paaralan. Ang feeding program ay mayroong dalawang bahagi— ang NFP o pagbibigay ng hot meal o food items gaya ng prutas, itlog, kamote, at nutty bars; at pasteurized fresh milk.

Sa 10 rehiyon, sinabi ng auditors na late dumating ang gatas o walang dumating sa buong school year.

Ang delay sa pagdating ng gatas sa NCR, CAR, and Region 1, 4B, 9, 10, 11, 12, at 13 ay isinisi sa Philippine Carabao Center o National Dairy Authority, at pribadong supplier. Nangyari umano ang delay kahit na-release na ang pondo sa unang quarter pa lamang ng 2023.

Sa Camarines Sur SDO, ang halos P100 milyong halaga ng produktong pagkain ay hindi dumating at ang supply contract para sa gasatas ay hindi nalagdaan.

Sa Palawan SDO, nauna umano ang pagbabayad sa supplier kayas sa pagdating ng mga pagkain.

Bagamat naipamigay umano ng mga SDO ang mga pagkain at gatas, sinabi ng COA na hindi nasunod ang guidelines ng DepEd Feeding Program dahil dinoble-doble na lamang umano ang ipinamigay at maging ang mga estudyante na hindi undernourished ay nabigyan. Ginawa umano ito upang hindi masira ang mga pagkain.

Upang matugunan naman ang delay o hindi na-deliver na gatas, iuusog umano ang procurement calendar upang matiyak na made-deliver sa oras ang mga gatas at mapapalitan ang mayroong mga problema.

Let this Order be published, at the expenses of the Petitioner in a newspaper of General Circulation, which will be raffled by the Office of the Clerk of Court, Regional Trial Court Branch, City of Dasmariñas, Cavite, among the duly accredited newspaper in the Province of Cavite, before the scheduled date of hearing, at least once a week for three (3) consecutive weeks.

Let the Office of the Solicitor General, the Local Civil Registrar of Dasmariñas City, Cavite, and the Philippine Statistics Authority be furnished with copies of the Petition and of this Order.



BOC Collects PhP615-B for First Eight Months of 2024

The Bureau of Customs (BOC) has exceeded its revenue collection target for January to August 2024. Preliminary reports indicate that the BOC collected a total of PhP614.781 billion during this period, surpassing the target of PhP609.592 billion by 0.9%, or PhP5.189 billion. This achievement reflects a significant 5.7% increase, or PhP33.290 billion, compared to the PhP581.491 billion collected during the same period in 2023.

The significant revenue growth underscores the BOC's effective strategies in valuing goods and ensuring precise import duty assessments. Through stringent customs compliance, the BOC has effectively minimized under-declaration and misclassification, enhancing efficiency, transparency, and overall fiscal management.

In August 2024, the BOC collected PhP78.908 billion. Although this fell 2.52% short of the PhP80.945 billion target, this

shortfall was largely due to recent policy changes. Executive Order (EO) 62, which reduced the rice tariff from 35% to 15%, accounted for a PhP2.353 billion revenue loss. Additionally, the reduction of the motor vehicle tariff to 0% resulted in a PhP1.034 billion deficit.

These policy adjustments were essential for broader economic and consumer benefits, reflecting a strategic shift towards more affordable essential goods. Despite these temporary setbacks, the BOC remains resolute in its mission to achieve its 2024 revenue goals. The BOC is actively addressing these challenges and working diligently to bridge the revenue gap, thereby supporting the country's fiscal health and stability.

Under the leadership of Commissioner Bienvenido Y. Rubio, the BOC is poised to sustain its positive revenue trajectory. These accomplishments not only support the nation's economic growth but also enhance the operational effectiveness of government functions.


