TCebu was struck by a magnitude 6.9 earthquake on September 30 at about 9:59 in the evening.

Indeed it was very traumatic as more than 3,000 aftershocks are being experienced. The epicenter of the earthquake was in the City of Bogó.

The magnitudes of the aftershocks have reached as high as magnitude 5.

Bangon CEBU!

The Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology (PhilVolcs) warned the public of possible landslides and falling objects when they go out.

"In case of another strongly felt earthquake, it is recommended that people protect themselves by doing the "DROP, COVER, and HOLD." In homes and offices, heavy furnitures and appliances should be strapped to the walls, and hanging objects securely fastened to avoid causing injuries," PhilVolcs advises.

Based on the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC) data that 72 persons were reportedly dead, 294 were injured. A total of 170,959 people have been affected, with 20,000 displaced.

More than 600 houses have been damaged, as well as 87 other infrastructure.

Overwhelming relief operations has been conducted not among Cebuanos but Province s and cities and municipalities sent cash aid and relief goods and medical and Rescue teams.

Cebu needs more prayers. Cebu Governor Pamela Baricuatro has been trying her best that relief and rehabilitation and recovery efforts are to be done asap.

P200-M Aid for Cebu Province says PBBM

President Ferdinand Marcos JR. announced on Thursday that more than ₱200 million aid package will be released for the Province of Cebu after a 6.9 magnitude earthquake struck the province.

In his visit to Bogó City, Cebu the Office of the President (OP) will have ₱50 million allocation.

While ₱20 million each for the City of Bogó, Municipalities of San Remigio and Sogod. ₱10 each for the municipalities of Bantayan, Daanbantayan, Madridejos, Medellin, Sta. Fe, Tabogon, and Tabuelan.

Additional support through the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) will be allocated for the

Local Government Support Fund(LGSF) for the Province of Cebu and ₱75 million LGSF for San Remigio, City of Bogó, and Medellin.

This announcement underscores the united effort of the national government together with Governor Pamela Baricuatro and local leaders to accelerate recovery, provide relief, and rebuild stronger communities in Northern Cebu. **(By RICO MIRASOL OSMEÑA)**

711 Tourism workers, 80 tourism establishments affected by 6.9 magnitude earthquake

The Department of Tourism in Central Visayas (DOT-7) bared on Friday that at least 711 tourism workers and 80 tourism establishments were directly affected by the 6.9 magnitude earthquake.

In its Public Advisory No. 2, the DOT reported that these workers were from hotels, resorts, restaurants, travel agencies, and transport services.

And the closure of dozens of heritage sites, resorts, and cultural institutions.

80 tourism establishments were directly affected, with damages ranging from minor cracks to total collapse.

Among the hardest-hit sites is the Archdiocesan Shrine of Santa Rosa de Lima in Daanbantayan, which

suffered 70 to 80 percent structural loss. San Isidro Labrador church in Tabogon collapsed its facade and roof. Sts. Peter and Paul Parish in Bantayan sustained partial damage.

And San Francisco de Asis Parish in Balamban had cracks and fallen statues. In San Remigio, the Capelinha de Fatima replica was severely damaged.

San Juan Nepomuceno Parish recorded ceiling damage, wall cracks, and fallen images.

San Ignacio de Loyola Church in Medellin reported a full ceiling collapse.

The Ala Mercedes Golf course was inoperable.

The Medellin Tourist Rest Area sustained roof and

wall damage.

In Bantayan island, Bontay Walk in Madridejos was closed due to damaged footbricks.

In Cebu City, cultural institutions including Museo Sugbo, Casa Gorordo, the Kabilin Center, National Museum of the Philippines -Cebu, and the Yap-Sandiego Ancestral House suspended operations pending inspection.

Several resorts in northern Cebu ceased operations including Pofor Beach resort, Maayo San Remigio, Hagnaya beach resort, San Remigio Beach club, Ogtong Cave resort in Sta Fe. **(By RICO MIRASOL OSMEÑA)**

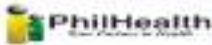
