The Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology (PHIVOLCS) clarified that the recent earthquakes recorded in Cebu, Baguio, and Davao Oriental are not seismically connected.

PHIVOLCS said the magnitude 7.4 earthquake that struck Davao Oriental on October 10; the magnitude 4.4 earthquake in La Union and Baguio City; and the magnitude 6.9 tremor in Bogo City, Cebu were triggered by different fault systems.

Recent earthquakes are not connected

PHIVOLCS emphasized that such seismic activity is normal in the Philippines, which sits along the Pacific Ring of Fire-- a zone prone to frequent earthquakes and volcanic eruptions.

The Philippines is located within the Pacific Ring of Fire. This "Ring of Fire" is 40,000 kilometers long and 500 kilometers wide spanning almost the entire Pacific Ocean.

Two-thirds of the world's active volcanoes are found in the Philippines while 90% of the world's earthquakes also occur in this belt.

We cannot escape our geography. But, we can do two things:

- 1.) Strengthen our disaster response system.
- 2.) Build infrastructure with these tectonic movements in mind.

An average of 18 major earthquakes between 7.0 and 7.9 on the moment magnitude scale and one great earthquake 8.0 on the moment magnitude scale and up

occur each year.

And 90% of these earthquakes happen along the Pacific Ring of Fire also known as the Circum-Pacific Belt where the Philippine Archipelago sits at the front seat.

All known 53 volcanoes in the Philippines and 75% of all volcanoes in the world are inside this ring of fire.

Earthquakes and volcanic eruptions in this area can be attributed to the movement of tectonic plates.

The zone where these plates overlap is called the subduction zone.

22 Sinkholes emerges after 6.9 Quake

At least 22 Sinkholes emerged after the magnitude 6.9 earthquake in north Cebu.

The Cebu Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office (PDRRMO) identified on Tuesday, 13 in San Remigio, eight in Medellin, and one in Borbon. Sinkholes are considered geological hazards.

Dr. Karl Queano, the chief geologist of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources -Mines and Geosciences Bureau (DENR-EMB) explained to media that many areas in Cebu are underlain by limestone, which increases the potential sinkhole formation.

Limestone is a sedimentary rock mainly made up

of calcium carbonate, often formed from the remains of marine organisms like coral and shells.

These materials accumulate, get compacted and Harden into solid rock.

The emergence of Sinkholes is a direct threat to public safety and infrastructure, transforming large sections of the island into high-risk areas for development and habitation. **(By RICO MIRASOL OSMENA)**

Repairs for Cebu Provincial Hospital in Bogo City begun

The Department of Public Works and Highways through its contractor has begun on Monday the repairs of the Cebu Provincial Hospital in Bogo City, Cebu.

ZLREJ Construction Corporation has deployed an initial 60 engineering team to work on buildings 1 and 17, including the emergency room and operating room which

are critical areas for patient care.

DPWH secretary Vince Dizon told media that aside from the repairs of the hospital, bridges and roads begun its repairs and rehabilitation.

"We will do our best to fast-track the hospital repair and make it usable within a week," said Malabanan Rejzl Awit, the Chief Operating Officer of ZLREJ

Construction.

The repair works includes restoring damaged hospital floors, walls, and roof decks, as well as fixing water leaks caused by the strong earthquake.

On growth, investment, and opportunity for all: 1.) Expanded programs that support local micro, small, and medium enterprises, farmers, and coastal communities; 2. Invested in essential infrastructure and digital connectivity to unlock opportunities in education, health, and commerce.

On People-first leadership and resilience: 1.) Strengthened social safety nets for the most vulnerable and

expanded community-based health initiatives. 2. Built a culture of teamwork, accountability, and service across my administration.

She assured of continuing the implementation of reforms that improve service delivery, transparency, and efficiency.

Baricuatro cited the first-ever Sea Ambulance launched as ensuring that island and coastal communities receive timely emergency care.

Low chance for another major Quake in Cebu says PHIVOLCS

The Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology (PHIVOLCS) bared on Thursday that very low chances that another major earthquake May hit Cebu.

DOST-PHIVOLCS Director Dr. Teresito Bacolcol said that based on historical data and the natural buildup of strain along fault lines as it May take centuries before enough stress accumulates to produce another powerful Quake like the magnitude 6.9 in Bogo City.

"At least in the north eastern side, maybe it would take several hundred years," Bacolcol told media.

"We haven't had an earthquake in that part for the past 400 years, so the recurrence phase could also take around 400 years. The strain loading would take hundreds of years until the rocks can no longer handle the stress, and that's when it would snap back," he stressed.

"Usually, the cycle or recurrence interval of major earthquakes is about a century or more," he added. "It happens when the rocks can no longer withstand the accumulated stress and eventually collapse."

PHIVOLCS clarified that while the northern part of Cebu is unlikely to experience another strong earthquake

anytime soon, the same cannot yet be said for central and southern Cebu, where more studies are still needed.

"That is for northern Cebu. But for central and southern Cebu, we do not have sufficient data yet, although we have potential active faults in the central part," Bacolcol disclosed. But he reiterated that people should remain prepared and aware, since earthquakes are inherently unpredictable.

The September 30 Quake left 72 people dead, over 550 injured, and around 611,000 residents affected. **(By RICO MIRASOL OSMENA)**

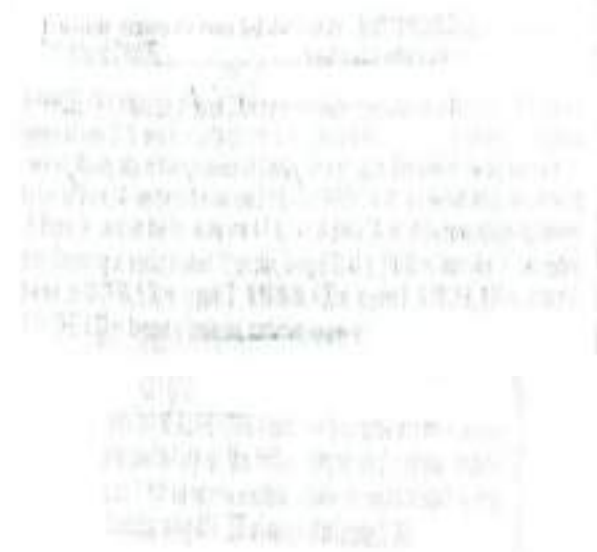

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In an effort to assist the victims of the recent earthquake in Cebu, officials from the Bureau of Customs, led by Commissioner Ariel Nepomuceno and MICP District Collector Rizalino Jose Torralba, have transferred abandoned and forfeited goods to the Office of Civil Defense. This donation, primarily sourced from the Manila International Container Port, comprises 56 Rapid Emergency Tents and 1,087 assorted tents intended to serve as temporary shelters, along with 50 mobile power supply units to provide electricity in the affected regions, and one bio-toilet unit to ensure adequate sanitation for displaced residents.
