More donations to come for earthquake victims in Cebu

Cebu Governor PAM BARICUATRO in her report to the public disclosed that more 132 million in monetary donations was received by the provincial government.

"The Province ensures transparent and efficient delivery of aid to all 15 affected location government units, with Bogo City, Medellin, and Daanbantayan receiving the largest assistance based on damage and population impact," the governor told

WATERFRONT NEWS.

She cited total resources distributed has reached to 1,435,388 with 810,883 liters of drinking water were provided to earthquake victims. 96,974 rice packs with 103,623 relief packs provided. With 253,051 medicines and medical supplies distributed.

According to the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC) there were 216,962 families or 748,025 persons were affected by the magnitude 6.9 earthquake in north Cebu. These families were residents in 260 barangays in Central Visayas.

Meanwhile, the Bureau of Customs of the Port of Cebu has raised 99,350 in cash donations, which was used to purchase essential commodities such as food item, hygiene kits, and drinking water.

A total 335 relief packs were distributed by the Port personnel to affected families in Barangay Daantabogon, Tabogon, Cebu.

"In times of calamity, the strength of our institution lies not only in our ability to collect revenue or secure our

borders, but in our willingness to extend a helping hand to those in need. When disaster strikes, our duty as public servants transcends the boundaries of our offices. It becomes a moral calling to extend our hearts to those who suffer, to remind them that their government stands with them, not above them. This effort is proof that compassion is the most powerful form of service. The Port of Cebu stands with our fellow Cebuanos as they build their homes, their communities, and their hope," BOC Cebu District Collector Atty. Felipe Georrey K. De Vera.

Earthquake damages over 7,500 classrooms in Cebu

The Department of Education in Central Visayas (DepEd-7) bared on Monday that more than 7,500 classrooms were damaged during the magnitude 6.9 earthquake.

Of the affected classrooms, 5,587 suffered minor damage, 803 were heavily damaged, and 1,187 were completely destroyed.

DepEd-7 Regional Director Salustiano Jimenez admitted as the current funds from the national government are not enough to cover the reconstruction expenses.

"Based on the 5th congressional district alone, the damage is already around 400 million. If you multiply that by all seven districts, so it's already more than a billion," he told media.

The Cebu Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (PDRRMO), nine towns and cities in

northern Cebu which includes Bogo City, San Remigio, Daanbantayan, Medellin, Tabogon, Sogod, Borbon, Tabuelan, and Bantayan, suffered varying levels of structural damage to school buildings.

Collapsed walls and unsafe buildings have been identified including San Remigio National High School and Cebu Technological University Daanbantayan- San Remigio extension.

More than 50,000 learners and at least 1,421 teaching and non-teaching personnel were affected by the earthquake.

As Jimenez confirmed that at least 12 students and two teachers were found dead in the aftermath of the earthquake.

Jimenez narrated that the rehabilitation process varies on the level of damages.

For classrooms completely destroyed have to be rebuild, those with significant damage will undergo retrofitting, and classrooms with minor damage will be repaired.

P240 million allocated to Cebu Province under the General Appropriations Act 2025 is only intended for new construction projects, and not for repair or retrofitting.

The Cebu Provincial Government under Governor Pamela Baricuatro has allocated 150 million for most affected Bogo City, San Remigio, and Medellin.

As part of the recovery efforts, the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) has allocated P375 million in emergency funds to Cebu.

Jimenez has urged collaboration between public and private sectors to assist in rebuilding the damaged school facilities. **(By RICO MIRASOLOSMENA)**

70 Sinkholes emerges after Quake in north Cebu

The Mines and Geosciences Bureau of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (MGB-DENR) in Central Visayas bared on Thursday that at least 70 Sinkholes emerged after the magnitude 6.9 earthquake in north Cebu.

There were 40 sinkholes in San Remigio; 16 in Bogo City; eight in Daanbantayan; two each in Medellin and Tuburan; and one each in Sogod and Tabuelan.

MGB-7 Supervising Geologist Josephine Aleta explained that the formation of sinkholes was primarily

caused by "extreme ground shaking", which aggravated by the region's highly soluble limestone composition that is prone to such occurrences.

"Hindi siya conducive for settlement area(It is not conducive for a settlement area)," she said.

Adding that while climate change and excessive ground water extraction can contribute to ground subsidence, not all cases result into Sinkholes.

With the 5.8 aftershock in October 13, Aleta said that eight current sinks will likely progress or new sinkholes

May be discovered.

"So far, tent cities are safe from Sinkholes," she added.

As she advised residents to avoid identified sinkhole areas and not use them as compost pits.

The Cebu Provincial Government suggested the possibility of reclassification and rezoning of the land use of the local government units affected because of the presence of sinkholes and the faultlines. **(By RICO MIRASOLOSMENA)**

SI Customs.Commissioner Ariel F. Nepomuceno ay isang mabuting tao na napili ng Pangulo BBM upang ayusin ang mga problema sa Customs.

Ang hangarin ng masipag na Commissioner ay ibalik ang magandang imahe ng Bureau of Customs.

Kaya naman lahat ay sinusuri ang mga bagay tulad ng pag-import at pag-export ng mga kalakal para hindi mapalusutan ang BOC, kaya naman sa kanyang unang 100days na panunungkulan ay marami na siyang magandang reporam sa Aduana.

Mayroong isang ulat na sinabi ng US Department na nagsasabing ang Customs ay pinaka-corrupt, ngunit si Commissioner Nepomuceno ay hindi nag-aalala tungkol doon dahil malinis ang kanyang pagkatao at pinili siya bilang Head ng ahensya upang mapabuti ang takbo ng Aduana dahil malaki ang tiwala ni Pangulong BBM sa kanya.

Sinusunod nila ang tagubilin ni Pangulong Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. na pahasayin ang seguridad sa hangganan at palakasin ang pagsisikap ng pambansang pamahalaan laban sa iligal na droga sa buong Port of NAIA.

Nasamsam ang mga shipment na may lamang 16,150 gramo ng methamphetamine hydrochloride, karaniwang tinatawag na shabu, na may tinatayang market value na 109,820,000.00, sa Paicargo Warehouse sa Pasay.

Ang mga paghahatid, na may label na e-commerce consolidated parcels, ay nagmula sa Hanoi, Vietnam. Matapos matukoy ang mga kaduda-dudang imahe sa panahon ng x-ray scan, isang kumpletong pisikal na inspeksyon ang isinagawa, na nagresulta sa paghahanap ng tatlong (3) Styrofoam container na may hawak na dalawampu't anim (26) na bundle ng puting crystalline na materyales na nakatago sa mga pakete ng co ee powder.

Ang mga field test na isinagawa ng CAIDTF at PDEA ay nagpakita ng paborableng resulta para sa methamphetamine hydrochloride.

Ang mga nakumpiskang ipinagbabawal na sangkap ay isinumite sa PDEA para sa nararapat na paghawak at karagdagang pagtatanong. Ang dalawang ahente ng consignee logistics firm ay nahuli sa lugar dahil sa paglabag sa Republic Act No. 9165 (Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002). Kinakatawan din ng sitwasyon ang mga paglabag sa Republic Act No. 10863 (Customs Modernization and Tari Act), partikular sa Section 1400 (Misdeclaration), Section 1401 (Labag sa Batas na Import at Exportation), at Section 117 (Regulated Importation and Exportation).

Pinuri ni BOC Commissioner Ariel F. Nepomuceno ang mabilis na pagtugon ng mga tauhan sa NAIA, at sabi niya, "Ang pagharang na ito ay binibigyang-diin ang pagiging alerto at pangako ng Bureau na pigilan ang mga sindikato ng droga sa pagsasamantala sa mga lehitimong ruta ng kalakalan para sa mga ilegal na aktibidad. "Ang aming dedikasyon sa pag-iingat sa aming mga hangganan ay hindi natitinig at determinado."

Kasunod ng paglitaw ng mga isyung ito noong huling bahagi ng Agosto 2025, ang pamahalaang lungsod, sa ilalim ng pamumuno ni Mayor Christian Natividad, ay mabilis na binuo ang Malolos City People's Audit Team.

Pormal na binuo ng Executive Order No. 39, na may petsang Agosto 29, 2025, ang audit team na ito, na kinabibilangan ng mga opisyal ng city hall, mga abogado, mga propesyonal, mga opisyal ng barangay, at mga ordinaryong mamamayan na nagboluntaryong lumahok. Ang misyon ng team ay imbestigahan ang mga proyekto sa loob ng Lungsod ng Malolos at tiyakin ang transparency at pananagutan.

Ayon kay Mayor Christian Natividad, naharap ang audit team sa malalaking hamon sa paghahanap at pagberipika ng mga proyekto. Ang mga pagkakaiba sa pagitan ng website ng DPWH, mga dokumentong ibinigay, at aktwal na lokasyon ng proyekto ay nakahadlang sa kanilang pag-unlad. Sa ilang mga kaso, ang mga coordinates ay nagdala sa kanila sa ibang-ibang mga lalawigan, habang ang mga proyektong baybayin ay napatunayang mahirap tukuyin dahil sa mga malabong paglalarawan.

Sa kabila ng mga hadlang na ito, ang Malolos City People's Audit Team ay nakagawa ng malaking pag-unlad.
