



Provincial Government of Cavite Brings Free Medical and Dental Services to Noveleta Residents



In its continuous effort to promote accessible and quality healthcare for every Caviteño, the Provincial Government of Cavite extended its free medical and dental services to the residents of Barangay San Rafael III, Noveleta, Cavite, on November 6, 2025.

The activity was spearheaded by the Office of the Provincial Governor's-Medical Mission Team, in partnership with the Office of the Provincial Health Officer, 1st District Board Member Jgys R. Gandia and Noveleta Mayor Davey Reyes-Chua. The joint effort reflects the province's continuing mission to bring essential healthcare directly to communities, especially those who have limited access to medical facilities.

A total of 451 residents benefited from the program, wherein they availed various free health services such as ECG for 23 patients, X-ray for 10 recipients, and dental services for 58 beneficiaries. The Province of Cebu encountered twin disasters this year and within a two-month period September 30 (earthquake) and November 4 (Typhoon TINO).

In November 1990, Typhoon Ruping tore Metro Cebu with winds reaching 250 kilometers per hour.

But Typhoon TINO is now described by experts as Cebu's worst Flooding in recent memory.

Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and

Astronomical Services Administration (Pagasa)-Visayas chief Engr. Al Quiblat said Tino brought 183 millimeters of rain over Cebu City in just 24 hours and it is 140 percent above the Cebu City's monthly average for November.

"Tino was worse in terms of rainfall, not in mind, here in Cebu City, we recorded maximum winds of 90 kilometers per hour. During Typhoon Odette in 2021, it was 165 kph. But when it comes to rainfall, Tino poured much more 183 millimeters compared to Odette's less than 100," Quiblat noted.

Pagasa data show that the only storm that dumped more rain in Cebu's history was Super Typhoon Ruping, which recorded 270 millimeters of rainfall over the same 24-hour period in 1990.

Quiblat said the contrast reveals how Environmental changes in the last three decades, such as urbanization, river obstruction, and the loss of natural

drainage systems, have made Cebu far more vulnerable to flooding. Tino is considered as the worst Flooding in Cebu.

"Every typhoon is different, so we must always prepare for the worst scenario. Our level of preparedness must double each time. We can't be complacent," Pag-asa-Visayas advises.

Local governments should ensure early warnings, clear waterways, and review evacuation plans while residents replenish supplies and stay alert for advisories.

Cebu City power restored by 80% as water supply by 60%

Cebu City Mayor Nestor Archival announced on Friday that the city now has restored power by 80 percent.

In an interview with DAILY TRIBUNE he clarified that the water supply remains at 60 percent due to power issues in Barangay Lusaran, which is one of the main water sources.

In Lusaran is the J.E Hydro and Bio-Energy Corp(JEBEC), the operator of the 30 million liters per day

of water.

He added that power is still down in Lusaran, and access remains difficult due to bridge damage.

"We've requested DPWH to build three temporary bridges especially in Lusaran, so the heavy equipments, and repair teams can access as soon as possible," he said.

In a letter to MCWD, JEBEC chairman ENGR. Jeo rey E. Hapitan said " Please be informed that stop-gap

restoration work for the JE Hydro Water Treatment Plant will commence as soon as power supply from VECO is restored and bridges to Lusaran Plant. The said stop-gap restoration is expected to be completed within seven days.

After the completion, JE Hydro will resume supplying potable water to MCWD. Permanent repair and upgrade work will continue to restore the WTP to full capacity and enhance its resilience to future flooding.'

Cebu Gov bares new Industrial Growth blueprint for Cebu

Speaking before the first ever Cebu Industrial Summit organized by the Aboitiz InfraCapital Inc., Cebu Governor Pamela Baricuatro told DAILY TRIBUNE that pursuing a new blueprint is one that combines strong infrastructure, sustainable innovation, and people-centered development.

Citing Metro Cebu remains the province's main economic driver, development must expand beyond it.

"Following a polycentric development approach, there will be industrial corridors to spread progress and opportunities: Secondary growth centers such as Danao City and Naga City will make up the Metro Cebu corridor.

This will support industrial expansion, with adequate land and infrastructure for businesses and workers. This will back the existing north industrial corridors from Consolacion to Carmen, Bogo City, San Remigio, Medellin, and Daanbantayan for the Northeast Corridor, with its vast lands, ideal for development of renewable energy like Acciona's 140 Megawatt solar farm.

Toledo City, Balamban and Pinamungajan for the west corridor will continue developing medium to heavy industries, integrated with neighboring corridors and the expanding Metro Cebu.

Talisay to Carcar will focus on being an industrial corridor for the southeast area while Bantayan and Camotes corridors will strengthen poultry and livestock production, and Southwest corridors will sustain and diversify tourism, showcasing Cebu's natural beauty, heritage, and culture," the governor narrated.

The new blueprint is guided by the Provincial Development and Physical Framework Plan(PDPFP), which is being currently being updated and envisioned by 2035.

She added that the province will prioritize human development.

"In our proposed budget for next year, over 30% will be allocated to healthcare -- from infrastructure and equipment to medicine and personnel development -- while continuing needed infrastructure investments," She stressed.

With the support of international partners such as the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), infrastructure projects like the Metro Cebu Sewerage System, the 4th Cebu-Mactan Bridge with a coastal road to improve access to the upcoming International port in Consolacion, and the Metro Cebu Expressway which will

eventually connect the entire island as an alternative national highway.

"What makes our approach different today is that we measure progress by International standards, focusing not only on infrastructure but also on human development and environmental stewardship.

We are committed to protecting our natural resources while working with universities and technical institutions to upskill our workforce for the industries of the future --green energy, AI, advanced manufacturing, and creative and knowledge-based sectors," Baricuatro said.

As she reiterated that her administration is grounded on three principles: People-first, transparency, and collaboration.

"We believe that development is not measured only in numbers, but in how many lives we uplift along the way as Cebu remains one of the strongest provincial economy in the country, being a hub of trade, manufacturing, creativity, and innovation," she noted.

"This, my friends, is Ato ang SUGBO -- Our Cebu. A Cebu that never stops creating, and never stops believing in its people," Baricuatro emphasized. **(By RICO MIRASOLOSMENA)**

DENR probes Hi-end Subd in Cebu City

The Department of Environment and Natural Resources in Central Visayas (DENR-7) bared on Saturday to investigate Monterrazas de Cebu project in Cebu City after reports that it greatly contributed to widespread flooding in the city.

In a statement, DENR said it has convened a Joint Inspection, Investigation, and Assessment Team composed of technical experts from the DENR-7, Environmental Management Bureau (EMB-7), Mines and Geosciences Bureau (MGB-7), Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office (PENRO)-Cebu, City Community Environment and Natural Resources-Cebu City, and Barangay Guadalupe.

The team on Friday began an on-site investigation to assess the project's compliance with the conditions of its Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC) and other environmental regulations.

The team will evaluate the effectiveness of drainage, slope protection, and runoff management systems, slope stability, and the risk of landslides and flooding.

Inspectors will further determine whether there have been alterations to natural land forms, encroachments to Timberland areas, or evidence of erosion, siltation, or obstructions in nearby tributaries and waterways.

"If the investigation finds any violation of ECC conditions or environmental regulations, the DENR will not hesitate to enforce corrective measures, including suspension, penalties, or other legal remedies as provided by law. We remain steadfast in our mission to balance development with environmental protection and to ensure that every project operates in full compliance with the law," warns the statement.

The Sangguniang Kabataan of Barangay Guadalupe in a resolution has called on to investigate the drainage and water retention systems of Monterrazas de Cebu.

Monterrazas de Cebu is a high-end Subdivision located in Barangay Guadalupe, Cebu city.

It's subdivision project started in May 2007, when EMB 7 granted Landco Pacific Corporation an Environmental Compliance Certificate.

In April 2008, the Cebu City government then temporarily revoked Landco's development permit due to mudslide in Guadalupe.

On March 2010, Genvi Development Corporation acquired full ownership of the Monterrazas from Landco.

In July 2011, the Cebu City government then issued a cease-and-desist order against Genvi after incidents of flooding in the neighboring lowlands.

In August 2011, the developer acknowledged lapses in flood control measures during the early stages of the project.

In February 20, 2019...8990 Holdings. INC bought out Genvi and took control of Monterrazas.

In December 2021, Typhoon Odette (Rain), it was scrutinized as it contributed to flooding in south Cebu.

August 24, 2023, The Rise at Monterrazas, a new luxury condominium project was launched by its industry partner Slater Young.

Nakasama rin ng NHA sa okasyon si San Remigio Councilor Miguel Martinez, na kumatawan kay Mayor Mariano R. Martinez.

Magsasagawa pa ng mga EHAP distributions ang NHA sa susunod na mga linggo para sa iba pang biktima ng lindol at bagyo.

Ang EHAP ay isa sa mga kasalukuyang programa ng NHA na nagbibigay ng tulong pinansyal sa mga pamilyang naapektuhan ng mga sakuna tulad ng bagyo, sunog, lindol at baha. Layunin nitong tulungan ang mga benepisyaryo na makapagsimulang muli sa pamamagitan ng pagsasaayos ng kanilang mga tahanan.

Samantala, kasalukuyan namang nagpapatupad ang NHA ng isang buwang moratorium sa pagbabayad ng housing loan at lease payment ngayong Oktubre para sa mga lalawigan ng Cebu at Masbate, bilang paraan ng ahensya upang maibsan ang pinansyal na pasanin na nararamdaman ng mga benepisyaryo matapos ang mga nagdaang trahedy.

PBBMOKs 'trigger-based' rice tariff system to stabilize prices

MANILA – President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. has approved a new "trigger-based" rice tariff mechanism designed to automatically adjust import duties depending on global prices as part of the government's thrust to stabilize rice costs and protect farmers.

Under Executive Order (EO) No. 105, signed on Friday, the existing 15 percent tariff on rice imports will remain in place until Dec. 31, 2025.

Beginning Jan. 1, 2026, the rate will adjust automatically by 5 percentage points for every 5 percent movement in world rice prices, within a 15 percent to 35 percent range.

Malacañang said the new mechanism replaces the flat tariff system under EO 62 (s. 2024) that balances consumer protection and farmgate support.

"The automatic tariff mechanism aims to ensure price stability for Filipino consumers while safeguarding fair

income for local farmers," the order stated.

To manage the new policy, Marcos created an Inter-Agency Group on Rice Tariff Adjustment to determine trigger levels, monitor global rice trends, and issue certifications when adjustments are warranted.

The group will be composed of the National Economic and Development Authority, Department of Agriculture, Department of Trade and Industry, Department of Finance, and the Office of the Special Assistant to the President for Investment and Economic Affairs.

The Palace said the interagency body will ensure "timely and evidence-based" tariff shifts while coordinating policy measures to maintain supply stability and curb speculative pricing.

The mechanism builds on the government's ongoing food security drive, following months of volatile rice prices. The tariff will stay at 15 percent for all rice imports, both within and outside quota, until the end of 2025. (PNA)

270K families, most from Bicol, evacuated due to Uwan

Over 270,000 families have been evacuated as a precautionary measure amid the possible devastation caused by Super Typhoon Uwan (international name Fung-wong), the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) said Sunday.

In an online briefing, OCD deputy administrator for administration Assistant Secretary Bernardo Rafaelito Alejandro IV said that as of 11 a.m., an estimated 270,682 families or 916,863 individuals have been preemptively evacuated in 11 regions.

The preemptive evacuations were conducted in the National Capital Region, Cordillera Administrative Region, Region 1 (Ilocos Region), Region 2 (Cagayan Valley), Region 3 (Central Luzon), Region 4A (Calabarzon),

Region 4B (Mimaropa), Region 5 (Bicol), Region 6 (Western Visayas), Region 7 (Central Visayas) and Region 8 (Eastern Visayas).

Alejandro said more than half of the evacuees, or 192,765 families, were from Bicol, followed by Eastern Visayas (32,020 families) and Calabarzon (24,209 families).

As of Sunday noon, Alejandro said strong winds and moderate to heavy rains were being felt in Bicol, especially in Catanduanes where several areas were experiencing weak telecommunication signals.

All provinces in Bicol, except Sorsogon, reported power outages as of 9 a.m. **(PNA)**

ICC warrants may be sent directly to law enforcement agencies – DFA

In an online briefing, OCD deputy administrator for administration Assistant Secretary Bernardo Rafaelito Alejandro IV said that as of 11 a.m., an estimated 270,682 families or 916,863 individuals have been preemptively evacuated in 11 regions.

The Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA) on Saturday said arrest warrants issued by the International Criminal Court (ICC) may be sent directly to law enforcement agencies.

The statement came after it was asked if it was aware about the supposed ICC warrant of arrest against Senator Ronald Dela Rosa.

"The Department of Foreign Affairs and the Philippine Embassy in The Hague have not received any warrant of arrest or related documents from the ICC, nor has any such document been uploaded in the ICC online portal," DFA spokesperson Angelica Escalona said.

"We note that under the Rome Statute, arrest warrants, if any, can be transmitted directly to law enforcement agencies of relevant countries."

The Philippines is no longer a state party to the Rome Statute after it officially withdrew on March 17, 2019. However, it insists that it has jurisdiction over alleged crimes committed during the period that the Philippines was a state party -- Nov. 1, 2011 to March 16, 2019.

Ombudsman Jesus Crispin Remulla, in an interview with dzRH, said an ICC arrest warrant had already been issued for Dela Rosa.

"At this point, we do not have independent confirmation as to whether or not this information is accurate," Dela Rosa's counsel, Israelito Torreon, said in a statement posted on social media.

Senate President Vicente Sotto III also reiterated that no senator may be arrested within the premises of the Senate, citing institutional dignity and courtesy.

Malacañang said on Saturday that it has yet to receive an official confirmation on an ICC warrant for Dela Rosa, who was the chief of the Philippine National Police during the Duterte administration's war on drugs.

In a separate statement, Executive Secretary Lucas Bersamin said that while the ICC might have issued a warrant, it has yet to transmit it through the International Criminal Police Organization (Interpol) for enforcement.

"Remember that ICC might have issued, but might not have yet coursed the service through the Interpol," he said. **(PNA)**
