

P38-M generated from Discaya couple seized vehicles

The Bureau of Customs (BOC) has generated at least 38,211,710 from the public auctioned motor vehicles linked to the Discaya couple.

Out of the seven (7) vehicles placed under auction, three(3) were successfully awarded to the winning bidder.

All proceeds were remitted directly to the Bureau of Treasury as reinforcement to the government's

commitment to ensuring that assets recovered from unlawful activities are returned to the public.

Earlier, the BOC had taken into custody 13 motor vehicles linked to the Discaya couple due to Customs law violations. Of these, seven were voluntarily forfeited and eventually publicly auctioned.

While forfeiture proceedings for the remaining six vehicles are underway, BOC Commissioner Ariel Nepomuceno, who oversaw the investigation and subsequent disposition of the Discaya vehicles, underscored the significance of the event in affirming the government's commission to accountability.

"Mas importante dito sa pera o pondo na maaring nating makukuha ay ang simbolismo o pagpapahalaga natin na pag ikaw ay gumawa ng mali ikaw ay mananagot, at ang pera ng bansa ay dapat pakinabangan ng ating mga kababayan," Nepomuceno stressed.

He added that the administration is determined to prevent similar incidents in the future, emphasizing that this

auction is only the first step toward full recovery and disposition of remaining assets linked to case.

For the vehicles that did not receive successful bids, the BOC will reconvene to recompute their floor prices for the next round of bidding.

The BOC plans to publish the revised prices by this week, providing interested bidders with another opportunity to participate while maintaining full transparency.

Cebu Archbishop urges to fight corruption but rejects violence

Cebu Archbishop Alberto Uy has urged Filipinos on Sunday to fight corruption and focus on uncovering the truth on the Flood Control irregularities.

"As investigations into alleged corruption in flood-control projects continue, many claims and accusations have surfaced. This has created confusion and opened the door to misinformation," Uy said in a pastoral statement.

The Archdiocese of Cebu circulated Uy's statement after resigned Ako Bicol Representative Elizaldy Co, published a video admitting facilitating insertions in the 2025 national budget pointing at President Ferdinand Marcos Jr and Tacloban Representative Martin Romualdez as having the blessings.

"I appeal to everyone to remain calm, peaceful,

and focused on the truth," Uy stressed.

Archbishop Uy's statement echoed other prelates statements, who spoke on the investigations which includes Manila Archbishop Jose Cardinal Advincula and Kalookan Bishop Pablo Virgilio Cardinal David, president of the Catholic Bishops' Conference of the Philippines (CBCP). **(By RICO MIRASOL OSMEÑA)**

ICI points at poor planning, master plan deviation, substandard implementation on Cebu flood control projects

Major lapses in the flood control projects in Metro Cebu were evident during the physical investigation conducted by the Independent Commission for Infrastructure (ICI) on Sunday.

ICI Special Adviser and Investigator Rodolfo Azurin raised serious concerns over the flood control projects. He revealed that the failures may be rooted on poor planning, deviation from the master plan and possible

substandard implementation.

He cited the 149-million project in the Liloan - Compostela area, which was awarded to a joint venture involving Alpha & Omega General Contractor & Development Corporation owned by the controversial Discaya couple.

Azurin questioned whether the damages caused by natural disasters were covered with insurance.

"If acts of God are not included in their insurance, the contractor will definitely have to shoulder the repair," he added.

The ICI first inspected the damage in Butuanon River in Barangay Tabok in Mandaue City then proceeded to Mananga River in Talisay City.

And in Cebu City, lastly in Cotcot River in Liloan and Compostela. **(By RICO MIRASOL OSMEÑA)**

Cebu Capitol enforces Tree-planting req't on Quarry permitted

Cebu Governor Pamela Baricuatro reiterated on Friday the strict imposition to plant trees on Quarry operators.

In her memorandum, Baricuatro directed the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office (PENRO) to implement Section 3(c)(2) of Provincial Ordinance 2016-21, which created additional division, sections, and permanent positions in PENRO.

The Provincial Ordinance requires quarry permit holders to plant one tree seedling for every cubic meter of extracted minerals and quarry resources within their host and surrounding communities.

In addition to the mandatory tree planting, the

ordinance also requires quarry permittees to: a.) Donate healthy endemic and fruit-bearing seedlings to the provincial nurseries, and b.) Build adequate drainage canals within their project sites during the validity of their permits.

The measure comes in response to recent flooding, soil erosion, and landslides in Cebu brought by consecutive typhoons this month, highlighting the need for stronger environmental safeguards in mining and Quarry operations.

This initiative complements the governor's broader efforts to prevent flash floods, including the push for integrated water management in Cebu.

It can be recalled that immediately after assuming office, she ordered a 30-day suspension of quarry operations in the province to allow a thorough review of contracts and compliance, underscoring that environmental protection has been a key priority of her administration from the outset.

Under Section 43 of Republic Act 7942 or the Philippine Mining Act of 1995, provincial governments may issue quarry permits for sites covering up to five hectares.

Permits exceeding this limit are issued by the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR). **(By RICO MIRASOL OSMEÑA)**

Sa matatag na pagpapatibay ng pamumuno ng Bureau of Customs sa masipag na pamumuno ni Comm. Ariel Nepomuceno ay nakagawa ng Php 38 milyon halaga mula mga nasamsama na mga Discaya Cars sa selyadong bidding na pampublikong auction na ginawa. Binibigyang-diin ng milestone na ito na ang mga paglabag sa batas ay may mga kahihinatnan, at ang sambayanang Pilipino sa huli ay nakikinabang mula sa pagsasauli ng mga ari-arian na nakuha nang labag sa batas.

Sa pitong sasakyang na inilagay para sa auction, tatlo ang matagumpay na naibigay sa nanalong bidder. Ang lahat ng mga nalikom ay direktang ipapadala sa Bureau of the Treasury, na magpapatibay sa pangako ng pamahalaan sa pagtiyak na ang mga ari-arian na nabawi mula sa labag sa batas na mga aktibidad ay maibabalik sa publiko.

Nauna nang kinuha ng Customs ang kustodiya ng labintatlong sasakyan na nauugnay sa Pamilya Discaya dahil sa mga paglabag sa customs. Sa mga ito, pitong units ang boluntaryong na-forfeit at kasunod na isinama sa public auction, habang nagpapatuloy pa rin ang forfeiture proceedings para sa natitirang anim na sasakyan.

Ginanap noong Nobyembre 20, 2025, sa Situation Room ng OCOM Building, ang auction ay sinundan ng isang linggong public viewing sa BOC Central Office. Upang matiyak ang transparency at public accountability, ang buong proseso ay na-livestream sa pamamagitan ng opisyal na Facebook page ng BOC. Pinangasiwaan ng Auction and Cargo Disposal Division (ACDD) ng Port of Manila (POM) ang aktibidad alinsunod sa Section 1118 at Sections 1139 hanggang 1151 ng Customs Modernization and Tari Act (CMTA), kaugnay ng Customs Administrative Order (CAO) No. 03-2020 at iba pang naaangkop na regulasyon.

Binigyang-diin ni Customs Commissioner Ariel F. Nepomuceno, na namamahala sa imbestigasyon at kasunod na disposisyon ng mga sasakyang Discaya, ang kahalagahan ng kaganapan sa pagpapatibay sa pangako ng pamahalaan sa pananagutan. Mas importante dito sa pera o pondo na maari nating makukuha ay ang simbolismo o pagpapahalaga natin na pag ikaw ay gumawa ng mali ikaw ay mananagot, at ang pera ng bansa

ay dapat pakinabangan ng ating mga kababayan. PGC extends health services to 1,231 residents in Bagtas

Bilang suporta mga katoto sa "Oplan Biyaheng Ayos: Undas 2025" ng Department of Transportation, sinabi ni katotong MIAA General Manager Eric Jose Ines na ang mahigpit na koordinasyon sa DOTr at NNIC ay nagsisiguro ng ganap na kahandaan sa lahat ng mga terminal sa panahon ng holiday rush, alinsunod sa direktiba ni katotong Pangulong Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. na tiyakin ang ligtas, mahusay, at komportableng paglalakbay para sa lahat ng Pilipino.

"Sa magkasanib na pagsisikap ng DOTr, MIAA, at NNIC, handa kaming gawing ligtas, maayos, at maginhawa ang paglalakbay para sa lahat ng pasahero ngayong Undas. Ang layunin namin ay makapaghatid ng world-class na karanasan sa paliparan kahit na sa mga pinaka-abalang araw ng taon," sabi ni GM Ines.

Ang NNIC sa ilalim ng pamumuno ni katotong General Maneger Lito Alvarez ay nag-proyekto na mahigit 1.3 milyong pasahero ang dadaan sa tatlong terminal ng NAIA mula Oktubre 27 hanggang Nobyembre 5, na may average na 135,000 hanggang 140,000 na mga pasahero araw-araw. Upang pamahalaan ang pagdagsa, isinaaktibo ang Oplan Undas 2025, na nagtalaga ng karagdagang kawani para sa tulong ng mga pasahero, pagsusuri sa seguridad, at pamamahala ng mga tao. The Cavite Career Caravan marked another milestone in the province's continuous efforts to support local employment as it opened thousands of employment opportunities for Caviteños during its leg on November 17 at Robinsons Palapa.

Spearheaded by the Office of the Provincial Public Employment Service Manager under Ms. Rizalie P. Enero, the activity was organized in partnership with Robinsons Mall Palapa management and supported by Ms. Jesuzaine Partoza, Public Employment Service Office (PESO) Manager of the City of Dasmariñas.

The caravan brought together 47 participating companies, collectively offering 10,832 job vacancies across various industries giving job seekers a wide range of career options.

A total of 540 applicants took part in the event, and 132 were hired on the spot, reflecting the program's effectiveness in bridging the gap between employers and qualified candidates.

The Bureau of Customs has transformed seized assets into substantial advantages for the country, generating 38,211,710 from the public auction of motor vehicles linked to the Discaya Family through a sealed bidding process.
