2nd Cavite Provincial Rabies Coordinating Council meeting highlights ongoing efforts in rabies prevention

The Cavite Provincial Rabies Coordinating Council successfully conducted its 2nd regular meeting at the Cavite Government Center in Trece Martires City, gathering stakeholders from various government agencies and academic institution to discuss updates, accomplishments, and upcoming activities aimed at eliminating rabies in the province.

Ms. Gladys Credo, Veterinarian II of the Office of the Provincial Veterinarian (OPV), presented the updates and accomplishments on the animal side, including vaccinations, spaying and castrations, and the number of rabies cases in the province.

Meanwhile, Ms. Charlene Rosanes, Nurse I from the Office of the Provincial Health Officer, provided an update on the human rabies situation, including the number of cases and deaths reported in Cavite.

An open forum followed to address additional concerns and gather suggestions and support for the council's future initiatives.

The meeting was led by Dr. May Magno, Provincial Veterinarian, together with the OPV team composed of Mr. Mark Jacob Espineli, Ms. Alma Fe Obidos, Ms. Sonia Penus, Dr. Gladys Credo, Ms. Marjo Mojica, and Ms. Sarah Laranjo.

Discaya's 28 Luxury Vehicles now under BOC's custody

The Bureau of Customs (BOC) confirmed that the 28 luxury vehicles owned by the Discaya family are now under their custody.

On September 4, the Discaya family surrendered 16 additional vehicles, on top of the 12 vehicles earlier secured through a court-ordered search at the St. Gerrard Construction General Contractor & Development Corp.

compound in Pasig City.

The 16 vehicles are now undergoing processing by the BOC for sealing and documentation and will be guarded by Customs personnel, pending verification of importation records and assessment of duties and taxes.

These Luxury Vehicles include Toyota LC300 3.3 V6 ZXAT SUV 2024, Maserati Levante Modena 2022, Rolls Royce Cullinan, Bentley Bentayga, Mercedes Benz G-500, Mercedes AMG G 63 AMG, Toyota Tundra, Toyota Sequoia, Cadillac Escalade (bulletproof), Jaguar F-Pace, Toyota Land Cruiser 300, GMC Yukon Denali SUV, 2 Lincoln Navigators, and others.

During the Senate inquiry, Cezarah Rowena Discaya dragged the name of Cebuano importer/ hotelier Harold Go.

Go was identified as the owner of AutoArt, one of two upscale car suppliers allegedly tapped by the Discaya's

to acquire high-end.

The other high-end vehicle supplier was Frebel Enterprises.

On the WATCH tried to contact Mr. Harold Go but as of this writing, he has not replied.

Go has hotels in Cebu, LapuLapu, and Quezon Cities.

Sinulog 2026 may limit to 35 contingents

The Sinulog Foundation Inc (SFI) is toying on limiting to 35 contingents the country's grandest festival, the Sinulog 2025.

"In fact, last year we already limited to 15 out of town, 10 from Cebu City, and 10 from Cebu Province, for a total of 35 contingents," said SFI Executive Director Elmer Labella.

He disclosed that as of to date, at least 10 contingents from Cebu City, Cebu Province, Luzon and Mindanao have already manifested their participation in next year's festival. Invitations were distributed as early as

April 25 to give ample time to prepare.

The SFI will also roll out tighter rules on floats to prevent last year's problems from recurring.

"Lately, we revisited all the rules and guidelines. If only the guidelines were being followed, there was no delays during the parade," Labella added.

Floats are capped at least 12 feet from the ground as stricter inspections will require early submission of concepts and layouts, giving time for organizers to order modifications when necessary.

SFI will be imposing qualifying rounds for the City-

based and youth- based categories. Only the top five performers in each will be allowed to proceed to the grand parade as this would reduce overcrowding and improve the quality of performances.

Commercial floats will be reminded to highlight the Sto. Nino, the centerpiece of the festivity, rather than their products.

Sinulog 2026 will remain at the Cebu City Sports Center (CCSC) as announced by Cebu City Mayor Nestor Archival.

P712-M Cash aid for typhoon victims returned to National Treasury

The National Housing Authority in Central Visayas (NHA-7) revealed on Thursday that over P712 million cash assistance for Typhoon Odette victims were returned to the National Treasury.

NHA-7 Regional Director Jude Juntillo cited that the province then under former Governor Gwendolyn Garcia wanted to handle the distribution by converting the

assistance into cash cards.

However, the NHA's program was designed to give P10,000 only to households with totally damaged homes, based on the Office of the Civil Defense (OCD) list.

Which recorded just 72,209 qualified beneficiaries in Cebu Province.

As compared to cash card conversion that may

benefit over 400,000 beneficiaries.

Because of the mismatch in figures and lack of agreement on the implementation process, the NHA central office decided not to proceed and returned the funds to the National Treasury.

Discaya firm cornered P244.5-M Flood Control projects in Liloan, Cebu

The Discaya-owned firm has cornered at least two flood control projects valued at P245.5 million in Liloan, Cebu.

Based on the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) Contract numbers 24H00016 and 24H00014, these two flood control projects were jointly awarded to MC Geometric Proportions Inc. and Alpha and Omega General Contractor worth P149,549,060 and to St. Matthew Gen. Contractor & Dev't Corp/ MC Geometric Proportions Inc. worth P96,474,783.85.

Contract agreements to both projects started April 1, 2024 and February 1, 2024 respectively signed by then DPWH-7 Regional Director Ernesto S. Gregorio Jr. and Cezarah Rowena Discaya.

Contract ID 24H00016 has been completed in August 2025. However, in a site inspection conducted by the DYLA news team, the project seems to have many concerns and incomplete (photo support courtesy of DYLA

Cebu radio).

The DPWH-7 in a statement released Friday said "We would like to inform the public that the project has already been completed last March 10, 2025 through the joint venture of Alpha & Omega General Contractor & Development Corp. and MC Geometric Proportions, Inc."

The project, officially titled Construction of Flood Mitigating Structure - Revetment Type, was completed with a revised contract amount of P149.5 M. It covers a total of 476.781 linear meters, located on the one-sided left bank facing upstream of the Cotcot River.

The completed structure now serves as a vital flood mitigation measure, strengthening river defenses and drainage systems to better protect the residents and communities of Liloan from risks of flooding. This accomplishment forms part of DPWH's continuing commitment to deliver resilient and sustainable infrastructure that safeguards lives and property.

Cebu Fifth District Representative Duke Frasco posted that he is personally offering a P500,000 reward for any credible information that could uncover anomalies or irregularities in Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) flood control projects within his district.

"Following the President's call for a nationwide investigation on flood control projects, I immediately asked the DPWH Regional Office to conduct a full review of all projects in the 5th District of Cebu," Frasco said.

"I will never tolerate any irregularities or substandard work, and I fully support efforts to uphold transparency and accountability in all government-funded projects," he stressed.

This as Cebu Governor Pamela Baricuatro on Friday announced, "To the People of Cebu,

Kamakailan lamang, nakipag-ugnayan si Bise Gobernador Alex Castro ng Bulacan sa isang komprehensibong panayam, kung saan tinalakay niya ang mga kritikal na isyu na kinakaharap ng lalawigan at binalangkas ang mga pangunahing inisyatibo na naglalayong itaguyod ang transparency at pananagutan. On August 19, 2025, a total of 590 residents of Ternate, Cavite received free medical, dental, and wellness services during a one-day Medical & Dental Mission organized by the Provincial Government of Cavite in partnership with the Office of the Provincial Health Officer and Board Member Jasmin Maligaya-Bautista.

The event, held at the Ternate Town Plaza Covered Court, prioritized vulnerable sectors including senior citizens, persons with disabilities (PWDs), farmers, and solo parents.

Around 530 individuals availed of general medical services, which included 18 x-rays and 8

electrocardiograms (ECGs).

Additionally, 60 patients received dental extractions. Aside from medical care, the mission also offered free haircuts, massages, and nail care providing holistic wellness to attendees.

Board Member Maligaya-Bautista, a staunch advocate for accessible healthcare, emphasized the importance of bringing services directly to communities.

The Provincial Government has been rolling out similar health outreach efforts across Cavite to address the gap in healthcare access for rural and underserved areas. (OPIO)
