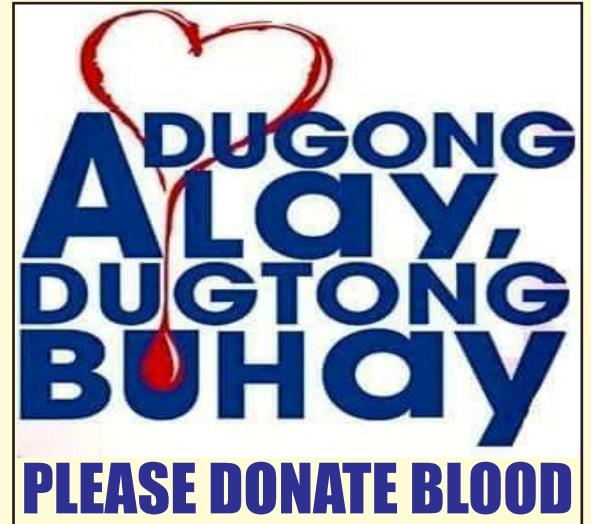

## PGC INCREASES CONCERN FOR THEIR CONSTITUENTS

Ensuring the safety of its constituents and persistently initiating programs that will be beneficial to the whole province, the provincial government of Cavite led by Governor Boying Remulla intensely facilitated programs which cater the most indigent members of the community.

Governor Remulla, with his brother Governor Jonvic Remulla were warmly welcomed by the residents of General Mariano Alvarez, Indang and the City of Dasmariñas during the Ugnayan sa Barangay Program held at Severino Delas Alas Covered Court, Indang Municipal Plaza, and San Marino City Central Subdivision Covered Court in Barangay Salawag. During the program, he communicated with the locals and articulated his readiness to attend to the needs of his constituents and identify the programs that are appropriate for the citizens. The chief executive also reiterated the projects being lined up by the provincial government including the

developments to ease the traffic in the province, boost the employment stability, comprehensive healthcare services for the indigents and housing projects for the poor. Gov. Remulla were joined by the local chief executives of the municipalities, together with the members of the municipal and city councils, and Sangguniang Panlalawigan Board Members who brought inspiration and motivation to the people.

Meanwhile, the governor also spearheaded the Lingap sa Kalikasan on December 18-24 and December 30-31, 2018 which was held at the municipalities of Noveleta, Carmona, Tanza, Alfonso, Ternate, GMA, Silang and the cities of Trece

Martires, Imus, Dasmariñas, and General Trias. Lingap sa Kalikasan aims to boost their crusade on ecological conservation and environmental protection. He encouraged his constituents to show compassion on the community where they live and value the essence of solidarity in supporting the programs for their locality as they simultaneously sweep the roads to ensure the cleanliness of the surroundings. Likewise, on December 22 and 24, 2018, the provincial government have distributed motorcycle vehicles for the barangay officials of Pagasa 1, Imus and in the municipality of Silang to guarantee the peace and order situation in their locality. The Provincial Government of Cavite and the Provincial Health Office in cooperation with the city government of Gen. Trias joined hands in celebrating World AIDS Day through the Inter-City/Municipality Volleyball League Open on December 6-7, 2018 at Gen. Trias Sports Complex in Brgy. San Juan.

This year's theme "Know Your Status" aims to urge people to know their HIV infection status through testing, to access HIV prevention, treatment and care services and

to urge policy-makers to promote a "health for all" agenda for HIV and related health services.

More than 400 members of the LGBT community in the province participated in the two-day event. Part of the program was the parade of muses with their respective team players.

**Customs implements TRAIN 2, Sin Tax Law!**

THE Bureau of Customs (BOC) under the Stewardship of Customs Commissioner Rey Leonardo B. Guerrero tightens its grip on revenue collection as it implements the TRAIN Law tranche 2 and Sin Tax Law in the bureau's E2M System effective 4 January 2019.

Acting upon the instruction of Com. Rey Leonardo B. Guerrero, the head of BOC's Management Information System and Technology Group [MISTG] Jeffrey Ian Dy issued a memorandum to District Collectors and others concerned on the updated excise tax rates for the products under TRAIN Law and Sin Tax Law.

For Minerals and Mineral Products or all domestic and imported coal and coke, the excise tax rate is One Hundred Pesos (P100.00).

For Refined and manufactured mineral oils and motor fuels, the rate of nine pesos (9.00) is applied to lubricating oils and greases including but not limited to base stock for lube oils and greases, high vacuum distillates, aromatic extracts and other similar preparations, and additives for lubricating oils and greases, whether such additives are petroleum based or not, per liter and kilogram respectively, of volume capacity or weight –P8.00, P9.00 or 10.00.

Same rate of nine pesos (P9.00) is used for locally produced or imported oils previously taxed but subsequently reprocessed, re-refined, recycled per liter and kilogram of volume capacity or weight; Processed gas per liter of volume capacity; Waxes and petroleum per kilogram; Denatured alcohol to be used for motive power, per liter of volume capacity; Asphalts, per kilogram.

Additionally, the nine pesos (P9.00) rate is also used for Naptha, regular gasoline, pyrolysis gasoline and other similar products of distillation per liter of volume capacity; Unleaded premium gasoline, per liter of volume capacity.

Meanwhile, an excise tax of four pesos and fifty centavos (P4.50) is applied to Diesel fuel oil, and on similar fuel oils having more or less the same generating power, per liter of volume capacity; Liquefied petroleum gas used for motive power, per kilogram; Bunker fuel oil, and on similar oils having more or less the same generating power, per liter of volume capacity; and Petroleum coke, per metric ton.

A two pesos (P2.00) tax rate is applied to Liquefied petroleum gas (for household use) per kilogram and four pesos and fifty centavos (4.50) for Liquefied petroleum gas (motive power used in taxis) per kilogram. Meanwhile, LPG used as raw material in the production of petrochemical products has zero excise tax. On the other hand, the excise tax rates on Alcohol and Tobacco Products shall be increased 4% effective 2018 onwards or every year thereafter.

With the implemented increase on oil tax rate, Com. Guerrero reminded all oil importers to comply with the new guidelines and directives. Com. Jagger Guerrero, also gave all district collectors strict directive to be on guard against all forms of oil smuggling and closely monitor their borders to prevent possible entry of smuggled oil shipments.

## CEBU TOP DESTINATION AMONG TAIWANESE



The world's leading online travel agency, EXPEDIA named Cebu as among the top 10 destinations among Taiwanese tourists for 2018. EXPEDIA said Cebu in the Philippines and Kuala Lumpur in Malaysia are the new additions to the top 10 international destinations visited by Taiwanese travelers in 2018.

Hongkong topped the list with Tokyo and Bangkok in the second and third spots respectively. Followed by Seoul, Osaka, Shanghai, Cebu, Macau, Singapore, and Kuala Lumpur.

Cebu Vice Governor Agnes Magpale, the chairperson of the Provincial Board(PB) committee. on tourism and international affairs, attributed Cebu's inclusion on the list to the increasing number of low-cost flights to Cebu.

Cebu Provincial Tourism Officer Joselito Costas said " If you base it on Expedia, they (Taiwanese) book bed and breakfast which will benefit local businesses. I would suppose that they will stimulate the local economy."

He added that the island's inclusion on the top list is a welcome development especially that flights from Taiwan to Cebu are considered short-haul.

" People now would love destinations which are near compared to long-haul flights," He said. There are so far two airlines that has direct flights from Cebu to Taiwan and vice versa.

The Department of Tourism (DOT) ranked South Koreans as top visitors in the region with Chinese, Japanese and Americans that follows.

Taiwanese were at the fifth with 74,355 visits in 2018 and 74,051 departures. Meanwhile, Bureau of Immigration(B.I.) records said that Chinese visitors for the past two years had increased.

In the first quarter of 2018, the total number of Chinese tourists visiting the Philippines has reached to 370,000 being the second largest source of tourists in the country.

The 2017 Chinese tourist count posted a 75.28 percent increase compared to 2016. In Central Visayas alone, where Cebu is part of, in 2017 rose to 429,306 from 244,925 in 2016 and 128,356 in 2015.

### DOTr forms TWGs to study prospects on motorcycles for hire as CEBUANO REPs one to legalize

The Department of Transportation(DOTr) has formed Technical Working Groups(TWG) to discuss issues and study the prospect of motorcycles operating as public transport.

This was disclosed yesterday by Land Transportation Office(LTO)- 7 Director Victor Caindec. This after the Supreme Court(SC) ruled and issued a Temporary Restraining Order (TRO) against the operations of motorcycles-for-hire.

DOTr added that the TWGs aim to discuss the appropriate standards and capacities of a motorcycle and its driver for public transportation service.

This as Cebu City Mayor Tomas Osmena with Cebu Archbishop Jose Palma has urged the Supreme Court to reconsider its ruling against the operations of habal-habal and Angkas or motorcycle-for-hire as more than 7,000 drivers in Cebu City alone has been affected and lost their livelihood.

Both Osmena and Palma assembled the more than 7,000

Angkas and Habal-habal drivers at the Cebu City Sports Complex few weeks ago.

Osmena vowed to help the affected drivers and family by assisting them initially of one sack of rice per driver but a registered voter of the city.

Lyndon Obaob, the spokesman of Angkas and Cebu Motorcycle Riders Group told DAILY TRIBUNE that their livelihood has been greatly affected.

He insisted that not only the 7,000 drivers in Cebu City that are affected but in Cebu province may reach to more than 8,000-10,000 drivers and minimum of 40,000 individuals, who are family members.

"Dont treat us criminals in the streets" Obaob said against the traffic police operations against drivers," Obaob reiterated.

Cebu City Police Office(CCPO) Director Senior Superintendent Goyina Garma promised an intensified campaign against colorum public transport, Angkas and habal-habal operations to ensure public safety.

"I think the wisdom in passing the law na bawal ang habal-habal is because of safety and general welfare of the public hindi lang economic progress ang i-consider. It also has to value the lives, and general welfare, lives are more important than economic reasons to justify the presence, or for tolerating habal-habal in the city," She explained.

Since, the SC ruling, the CCPO had its crackdown against Angkas and habal-habal drivers and resulted into more than 1,000 apprehensions.

At least three Cebuano Congressmen in separate interviews with DAILY TRIBUNE said today, they will follow up before the House Committee on Transportation the pending House Bill(HB) 6909 or " An Act Regulating Motor-for-hire known as habal-habal or Angkas, Thereby authorizing Cities and Municipalities to grant franchises for their operations, amending for the purpose 458(i) (Vi) of Republic Act(RA) 7160 as amended, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of the Philippines.

Congressmen Raul del Mar (North District, Cebu City) and Rodrigo Abellanosa (South District, Cebu City) sponsored HB 6909, who sponsored and co-sponsored the bill yesterday to push the bill as the House regular session convenes.

Del Mar the HB has long been filed but some congressmen do not feel its urgency. But Abellanosa said they will intensify their representations in the House starting today. Congressman Jonas Cortes (Sixth District, Cebu Province) expressed support to HB 6909.

"Habal-habal motorcycles has been a mode of transportation for the Filipinos not only in the hinterlands but now also in the urban areas due to its convenience most especially in traffic areas as they can weave thru traffic better than 4 wheel transport. As long as the safety of the commuters and the riding public is the top priority. I would gladly support the legalization and regulation of Habal-habal for hire," Cortes explained.

The TWG will be comprised of representatives from the DOTr, Land Transportation Office(LTO), Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board(LTFRB), Philippine National Police(PNP), -Highway Patrol Group(HPG), Metro Manila Development Authority(MMDA), the Senate, the House of Representatives, commuter welfare groups, road safety advocates, motorcycle manufacturers, motorcycle organizations, and Law schools.

To recall, on December 5, 2018, the Supreme Court slapped a TRO on the previous Preliminary injunction issued by the Mandaluyong Regional Trial Court(RTC) Branch 213 that favored continuing Angkas operations.

The TRO effectively allows the resumption of law enforcement operations against Angkas drivers which are considered as colorum.

Republic Act No. 4136, or the Land Transportation and Traffic Code, which mandates that two-wheel vehicles cannot engage in business or offer public transport.

**Legarda: Senate Will Prioritize Passage of 2019 Budget**

Senator Loren Legarda, Chair of the Senate Committee on Finance, today said that the Senate will prioritize the passage of the proposed 2019 national budget when session resumes on Monday, January 14.

Legarda said that the Senate will continue to hold marathon sessions to ensure immediate approval of the 2019 budget.

Upon resumption of session, the budget of the following agencies will be subject to plenary debates: Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), Department of Tourism (DOT), Department of National Defense (DND), Department of Health (DOH), Bureau of Immigration, Commission on Elections (COMELEC), Dangerous Drugs Board (DDB), Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA), Presidential Legislative Liaison Office (PLLO), and National Commission on Indigenous Peoples (NCIP).

The Senate aims to approve the budget by January 21, to be followed by the convening of a bicameral conference committee, then the approval of the bicameral report by both the House and the Senate before the last day of session on February 6.

"We aim to have the budget signed by the President by the second week of February," said Legarda.

Legarda also assured that the Senate will pass a budget that is geared towards improved programs and services for the people, gradually eliminating underspending.

"While pressed for time, we will perform our duty to pass a budget that is geared towards our collective desire to provide our people with programs and services that would usher in personal growth, community development and national progress. We want to ensure that every peso from the people's taxes go back to them through actual delivery of services and programs," Legarda concluded.

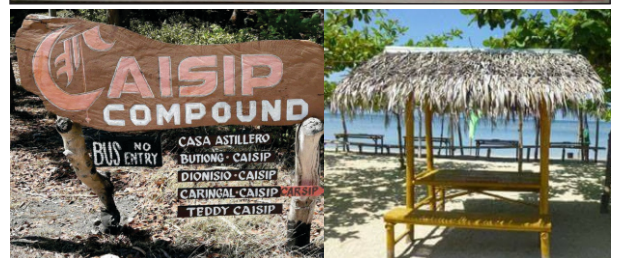
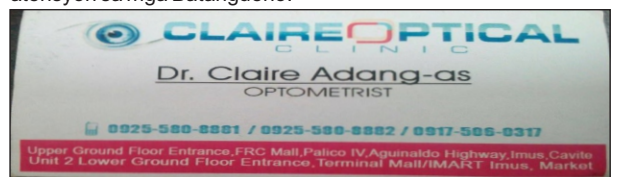
