

Cavite GFPS goes on a learning visit to Los Baños

In line with the goal of becoming a more gender-responsive province, the Technical Working Group of Cavite Gender and Development Focal Point System spearheaded a learning visit at the Gender and Development Office in the Municipality of Los Baños, Laguna recently.

Karen Lagat-Mercado oriented the group on the Best Practices in GAD mainstreaming of Los Baños LGU with emphasis on the development of GAD Database. It is a manifestation of the municipality's strong commitment to the advocacy since it serves as basis for gender responsive planning, programming and policy formulation.

There were 449 types of data needed in the database gathered from 14 barangays using results of the Community Based Monitoring System survey and data coming from various offices of the municipal government. It was narrowed down into several sectors such as social development, economic development, infrastructure and environment sector, institutional sector and gender mainstreaming for ease of identification and appreciation

Ms. Mercado also highlighted that the success of the LGU's GAD advocacy is mainly attributed to the commitment of the Local Chief Executive and the strong support of the legislative body which gave way to the passage of gender-responsive local policies, fiscal administration and governance, in general. Community involvement also contributed to successful implementation of the GAD programs.

Meanwhile, the Municipal Civil Registrar and ICMS Head, Mr. Glenn N. Arieta shared to the participants their milestone in creating the database which started with the issuance of Executive Order No. 59 series of 2016 directing the Organization of the Los Baños Information & Communication Management Services (ICMS). After series of meetings with other offices, agencies, the academe and with the combined

effort of GAD Council thru the GAD Office and the ICMS Team, the Los Baños GAD Database was formally launched on August 8, 2018.

After the briefing, the delegation made a courtesy call to Municipal Mayor Caesar Perez who welcomed the team and shared some of his undertakings in local administration. He encouraged each participant to do his own share towards a successful government. "Ang pagbabagong hinahanap nyo ay mag sisimula sa bawat isang mamamayan hindi lamang sa aming nanunungkulan," he added. He thanked everyone for coming with a hope that they have imparted new learnings to the group.

Sa isang munting pananghaliang naganap, naging bukas sa kanyang mga adhikain si katotong Commo Punzalan sa command Staff nito na pinangunahan ni Deputy Commander LOGCOM Capt Neil Azcuna kung saan binigyan ito ng kanyang tungkuling gagampanan na inatasang patuloy na pararatingin ang bawat ulat nito araw-araw upang patuloy na masubaybayang pangkalahatang pangangailangan ng Philippine Coast Guard (PCG).

Sa halip kasi ang patuloy na pagbibigay ng proteksyon para sa interes ng ating gobyerno ang pangunahing layunin sa kanyang paglilingkod, aba, e, sariling kapakanan ang inaatupag na gawin. Tiyak may paglalagyan ang taong ito. May update ito, pramis! Abangan!

Gayuman, alam ba ninyo na inamin ng ilang opisyal ng Bureau of Customs na dismayado sila sa napaulat na "nai-swing" ang may 555 container vans imported products bago nasunog ang dalawang palapag sa bahagi ng gusali ng Port of Manila (POM), collection district ng ahensya noong nakaraang February 22, dakong alas 9:00 ng gabi?

Opo! Ang tinutukoy nating shipments na sinasabing bilyun-bilyong piso ang halaga ay gaya ng "general merchandise," "ceramic tiles," "rice" at "sugar" buhat sa ibat' ibang bansa at umano'y magkakahiwalay na dumating sa bakuran ng POM noong nakaraang taon.

Umano'y naipuslit ang mga kargamento sa pamamagitan ng "pag-untagging" at "pag-trigger" sa POM-Informal Entry Division sa (IED) sa pagitan ng mga buwan ng Enero at unang linggo ng Pebrero ng kasalukuyang taon. Sinasabing walang import documents at hindi nagbayad ng duties and taxes sa Customs. Alyas "Mimoso" na taga-IED ang umano'y promotor-lider nang swing operation na ito.

Pero nakatakdna raw imbestigahan ng Kongreso ang kontroversyal na isyung ito na pinaniniwalaang malaking sindikato na kasabat ang ilang tiwaling BOC personnel ang nagmaniobra.

Tama ang aking hinala na mapapansin ito ng ilang matatalino't masisipag nating mambabatas pagkatapos na sumabog ang naturang iskandalo sa media. Marami kasing mata at kritiko ang patuloy na nakasubaybay sa Customs. Mahirap itago o ilihim ang nangyayaring mga kabulastugan sa loob ng Adwana. Lilitaw o sisingaw ang amoy.

Ayon sa Customs insider, magpatatawag ng congressional hearing si Congressman Prospero Pichay kasunod ang gagawing pagtatakda rin ng imbestigasyon ng Senate Blue Ribbon Committee ni Senator Dick Gordon para sa tuluyang paglininaw sa umano'y nadiskubreng smuggling operations sa POM. "Posibleng malaking sindikato ang may gawa nito. Nararapat lamang talaga na imbestigahan. Nakakahiya man

CUSTOMS- COAST GUARD CEBU ON ALERT VS. COCAINE ENTRY

The Bureau of Customs(BOC) and Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) in Central Visayas has been alerted and monitoring to prevent the possible entry of cocaine in the region.

Cebu Customs District Collector Atty. Elvira Cruz in an exclusive interview with DAILY TRIBUNE said she has ordered the Customs Intelligence and Investigation Service(CIIS) and the Emergency Security Services-Customs Police Division(ESS-CPD) to be "on alert" on the possible entry of cocaine,ecstasy and shabu on board international vessels and aircrafts.

"We are very sorry for the inconvenience as we have to be more stricter on incoming cargoes whether it enters via Cebu International Port(CIP) or at the Mactan Cebu International Airport(MCIA),"she insisted.

But Cruz clarified that in terms of seacrafts to monitor international vessels,it is the PCG that has the equipments and seacrafts for monitoring.

PCG- 7 Commodore Ronnie Gil Gava in a separate interview said " We are not letting our guards down,after recently, may mga suspected blocks of cocaine retrieved sa ibang probinsya. We are doing our part, and we can do random checks in our areas with our K-9 units who are trained to detect them." He added that random inspection will be conducted in coastal areas in Central Visayas.

President Rodrigo Duterte disclosed Colombia cartel has already infiltrated the country. Citing the drug syndicates known as Sinaloa cartel of Mexico and Asian Bamboo Triad.

The Philippine National Police (PNP) and Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) seized 165 kilogram of blocks of cocaine worth P871.674 million in Tandag City in Surigao del Sur province,Dingalan town in Aurora province, Caraga town in Davao Oriental province and Dinagat islands.

MUNTI BASED DRUG RING NOW LORDS OVER CEBU SUPPLIES

After neutralizing the illegal drugs operations of Visayas based known drug lords Peter Lim, Kerwin Espinosa and Franz Sabalones, olice and drug enforcement agencies disclosed the entry of new players especially in the Province of Cebu. The revelation was made yesterday by the Intelligence Division(I.D.) of Police Regional Office(PRO-7).

And the new player was identified as Rustico Ygot drug syndicate who is now an inmate in the National Bilibid Prisons in Muntinlupa City. The new player was traced when Police and Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) operatives raided two drug dens last week in Barangay Inayawan in Cebu City and Barangay Casili in Consolacion.

It yielded P190.4 million worth of shabu in two buy bust operations on known Drug Queen Jocelyn Encilla and Elymar Ancajas. Encila, upon the orders of Ygot, reportedly receives,stores, and distributes the illegal drugs shipped from Mindanao and Luzon.

Encila has a cousin in Bohol who is a police officer with a rank of Police Officer 2 assigned in the Bohol Provincial Police Office(BPPO) and a resident of Barangay Tangke in Talisay City.

A former japayuki,Encila had a romantic relationship with Ygot and had three other relationships with Arglo Garces,a known bigtime drug lord, an intelligence officer of the Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) and a Police Officer with the rank PO3.

The proof of the relationships was Encila's phone where they were together in vacations, family events and visits in Encila's farm. The PDEA released the Ygot Drug Ring matrix yesterday to the media.

Senior Superintendent Remos Medina, the Intelligence chief of PRO-7, the group disposed 300 kilograms or P2.4 billion

OMBUDSMAN ASKED TO PROBE PLUNDER ON TOLEDO CITY'S GHOST EMPLOYEES WORTH P210-M

The Office of the Ombudsman yesterday has been requested to investigate the possible Plunder of public funds ostensibly paid to Job Order(JO) employees in the highly questionable and irregular "Clean and Green Program" of the City of Toledo, Cebu.

Former Third District Congressman Pablo John Garcia yesterday led 21 out of the 38 barangay captains of the city in filing the request to investigate the matter before the Ombudsman which according to documents had reached to P210 million through three supplemental budget resolutions in 2018.

Garcia said " In its Annual Audit Report for Toledo City in the Fiscal Year 2017, the Commission on Audit(COA) had already noted the highly suspicious and irregular disbursement of more than 100 million pesos in public funds supposedly paid to so-called Job Order(JO) employees whose existence, identities and actual work were in question.

The COA noted in item 6 of their report that " The necessity of hiring Job Order(JO) employees could not be established due to lack of contracts and doubtful daily time records of most job orders doing the fieldwork, thus the regularity and propriety of expenditures totalling P113,265,231.40 could not be ascertained.

In addition, some JO personnel hired did not perform piece of work or intermittent job of short duration and services rendered exceeded six months."

However, Garcia added " Despite these findings, and in defiance of the recommendations of the COA, the City of Toledo continued these questionable practices in the implementation of a 210 million peso Clean and Green Programs for Fiscal Year 2018 as follows: 1. Supplemental Budget No. 2 approved on 30 May 2018 of P70 million; 2. Supplemental Budget No. 7,approved on 25 October 2018 of P60 million; and 3. Supplemental Budget No. 8 enacted on 10 October 2018 of P80 million.

"The fund, ostensibly to employ job order (JO) employees at P350 per day to clean and green Toledo, was appropriated thru supplemental budgets in three tranches beginning in May and ending in October of 2018.

Considering the sheer magnitude of the fund, there should have been a clear and unmistakable improvement in the hygiene and landscape of the city," Garcia insisted.

The people of Toledo City has been asking Why is there no visible sign of any JO employees cleaning our barangays?

If you do the math,P200 million for six months is around P33 million a month. Working at P350 a day for 20 days a week, there would have been--at any given day-- 4,760 JO employees working in the 38 barangays of Toledo City. And yet if you ask any resident, no sign of these Clean and Green JO employees was evident during the last half of 2018.

In several sworn affidavits by residents and former JO employees disclosed that the employees are made to fill up personnel data sheets, daily time records and sign the documents and are being paid for P1,500 to P2,000. While many in the JO payrolls are fictitious persons and are non residents nor registered voters of the city. In a press conference after the filing, Garcia revealed that there were JO employees in the payroll that are employees of Gaisano Metro in Toledo City,a seaman who is abroad, a college student studying in Cebu City and an employee of Jollibee in Toledo City.

As he urged the Ombudsman to preventively suspend Mayor John Henry Osmena, Councilors Marjorie Perales and Leo Dolino, Executive Assistant II Justin Anthony De Jesus, Officer-In-Charge(OIC) Budget Officer Gethsemane Mahinay, Officer-In-Charge(OIC) City Administrator Ferdinand Marquez, City Treasurer Leonardo Rivera Jr.

Human Resource Management Officer(HRMO) Edwin Abad, City Accountant Ramon Samper and Liga ng mga Barangay President Ophelio Dolino.

Garcia presented to media several payroll documents that the handwriting on signatures are clearly "forged" as there is one ballpen used and the penmanship are all the same. Mayor Osmena was unavailable as of press time.

BI AGENTS NAB BIGTIME KOREAN SWINDLER

The Bureau of Immigration (BI) is deporting another South Korean fugitive wanted for swindling nearly a hundred people in three Asian countries through telecommunications fraud that caused the victims to lose more than half a million dollars.

BI Commissioner Jaime Morente said operatives from the bureau's fugitive search unit (FSU) arrested last Wednesday inside his unit in a high-rise condominium tower in Makati City 40-year-old Kim Youngin.

Morente said he issued a mission order for Kim's arrest after the South Korean embassy informed the BI about the fugitive's crimes.

"He (Kim) no longer holds a valid passport because it was already cancelled by the Korean government. He will thus be deported for being an undocumented and undesirable alien," the BI chief added.

According to BI-FSU chief Bobby Raquepo, Kim is also an overstaying alien as he failed to extend his stay since he last arrived in the country as a tourist in August 2015.

Raquepo added that Kim was issued an arrest warrant by a Korean court after he was indicted for large-scale fraud and swindling.

Korean authorities alleged that Kim established and headed a voice phishing organization named "Hoon- yi" which engaged in telecommunications fraud in Incheon Korea; Weihai China and Cambodia from April 2012 up to March 2015.

By pretending to be a counselor of a company called D-REX that offered low interest loans to prospective customers, Kim and his cohorts reportedly defrauded their victims in the said three countries of more than \$530,000.

Investigation also revealed that the syndicate had a database with the personal information of their victims which they utilized to contact, deceive and entice their victims to give them money in exchange for processing their loan applications.

It was further alleged that the fraudsters resorted to voice phishing which enabled them to engage in identity theft and gain access to the private, personal, and financial information of their victims.

Ilocos RDC recommends PORTASOL dryer use

AOAG CITY – The Ilocos Regional Development Council (RDC 1) has noted the very encouraging feedbacks they have gathered from Ilocano farmers and many others from various regions, on how the Portable Solar Dryer (Portasol) has benefitted them since RDC 1 commended and endorsed the technology in 2018, following its introduction to them the previous year.

In their 2018 resolution, the RDC 1 Board urged "all government instrumentalities" and concerned groups to promote the Portasol technology among farmers and other users of drying facilities after it found the equipment to be highly effective and efficient in drying not only palay but also other high-value crops including corn and tobacco and even fish.

National Economic Development Authority (NEDA) Ilocos regional director and RDC 1 vice chair Nestor Rillon said it is necessary to address the insufficiency of post-harvest facilities in the region that "aggravates the practice of drying palay on national roads and highways, which poses danger to lives while causing tremendous grains losses worth billions of pesos."

Rillon noted that for decades, no significant solution has been made to address the country's post-harvest problems. The DPWH has banned palay drying along highways but the ban is hardly noticed. "The Portasol drier is both timely and crucial in "achieving what the country needs now," he stressed.

A study by the Bureau of Postharvest Research and Extension indicates that the country suffers tremendous losses worth billions of pesos from wasteful drying practices. The lack of post-harvest facilities complicates the problem further because "farmers are compelled to sell their fresh palay to dealers at low

prices" and rice dealers use the highways to dry them.

The Portasol is a Filipino invention. It was developed by Francisco "Popoy" Pagayon, president of the Filipino Inventors Society (FIS) and the FIS Producers Cooperative (FISPC) who said he designed it for drying palay and other high-value crops, including fish; save grains losses; help address risks to farmers and commuters' lives along highways; and help spare motorists from being held hostage by workers of big-time rice dealers who even install physical barriers so vehicles will not run over the grains they dry.

To discourage big rice dealers from using the highways to dry their grains, Pagayon said the government may consider imposing "fines" on a per-square-meter basis of the paved road space they occupy. (Win Bataller)


