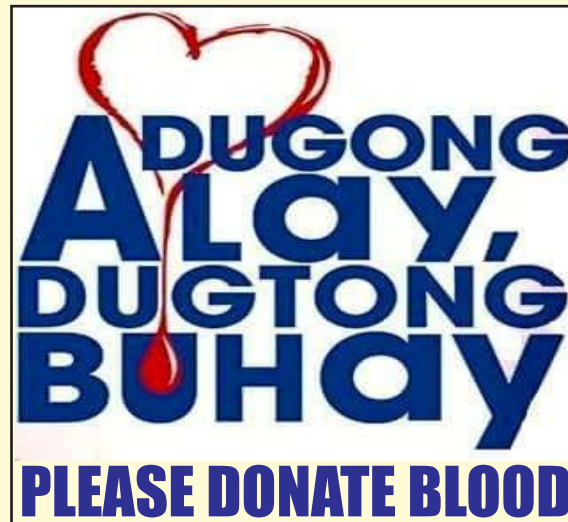

Annual Nutrition Evaluation, on-going in Cavite Province

The Provincial Nutrition Evaluation Team (PNET) composed of different departments of the provincial government and national agencies in Cavite conducts the Annual Monitoring and Evaluation of City/Municipal Nutrition Program Accomplishments in 2018 using the new Monitoring and Evaluation of Local Level Plan Implementation Pro tool (MELLPI-Pro).



STRENGTHENING KILATIS KUTIS CAMPAIGN IN THE CITY OF GENERAL TRIAS: More than 170 residents of Pabahay in Barangay San Francisco in the City of General Trias have availed free skin consultation during the conduct of Kilatis Kutis Campaign on May 30, 2019. Barangay Chairman Eduardo Umali expressed his gratitude to the provincial government thru the Provincial Health Office with the support from the City Health Office of Gen. Trias for visiting their community and checking the health conditions of their constituents. During the event, Ms. Haydelisa Maderazo, National Leprosy Control Program (NLCP) provincial coordinator facilitated a short lecture on leprosy awareness and how it could be treated. Together with Dr. Cherry Aspuria and Dr. Jonathan Euseco of the City Health Office, they patiently rendered free checkup and consultation to the residents who have skin disease problems. Patients who were treated were given free ointments to cure their skin disease and vitamins to enhance their immune system. The team have also conducted home visit to two locals who have leprosy and psoriasis problems. Nurses and some volunteer medical practitioners from the City Health Office with the barangay health workers were also present during the Kilatis Kutis Campaign. (PICAD)



JOURNEY TO ADULTHOOD: Residents of Barangay Bagtas in the municipality of Tanza showed their appreciation to the provincial government of Cavite thru the Office of the Provincial Governor-Extension as another leg of Operation Tuli was held in their vicinity on May 29, 2019. One hundred fifty-four boys were circumcised and bravely walked at the journey of adulthood as they happily passed the pain of circumcision. The operation was performed by medical professionals from General Emilio Aguinaldo Memorial Hospital (GEAMH) with Dr. Francis Nikolai Pacumio. Medical practitioners from the Municipal Health Office and barangay health workers were also present who assisted in the operation tuli. Likewise, Barangay Chairman Engr Manuel Clemente Mintu Jr thanked the team for conducting another health care services to the people of Tanza and providing medicines for their constituents. It is the updated monitoring and evaluation framework and system for the nutrition sector covering assessment of nationwide initiatives along policy and legislation, nutrition service delivery, and capacity building. MELLPI Pro is coined from the words Protocol that includes procedures and tools; Promotive since it promotes awareness and observance to existing laws, rules and guidelines; Progressive that scoring is based on desired progress of LGUs in terms of nutrition program implementation and Professional because it promotes professional and objective review of evidence using rubrics and spider web diagram. The new tool was designed to evaluate and assess the performance of the City/Municipality and local nutrition workers including Nutrition Action Officers. The validation visit kicked off in the Municipality of Rosario on May 2, 2019 and will conclude on June 7, 2019 in the Municipalities of General Mariano Alvarez and Silang. So far, Tanza and the cities of Damarifias, Bacoor and General Trias had been validated by the team.

During the visit, the PNET conducts a desk review of accomplishment reports based on the Nutrition Action Plans and other pertinent documents from where individual rating, consensus rating then finalization of rating will be generated. A report will be prepared to be presented to the Local Nutrition Committee in a meeting and members of the team will review the MELLPI Pro Process, the over-all results and highlights of nutrition-related policies, programs and services. The team acknowledges the LGUs performance and best practices and recommends actions for improvement based on the PNET's monitoring. A summary of evaluation findings and recommendations and the signed Form 4 are submitted to the Local Nutrition Committee or Local Nutrition Worker during the exit meeting. (PICAD)

BOC tightens security against ASF!

THE Bureau of Customs (BOC) under the stewardship of Customs Commissioner Rey Leonardo B. Guerrero, on Thursday, reiterated its continued efforts against the entry of banned meat products from affected countries of African Swine Fever (ASF).

All ports of entry are continuously being monitored to safeguard the country's borders against the entry of contaminated pork and pork products with ASF.

The Bureau reiterated that only importers with proper clearances and permits from government agencies tasked to regulate certain commodities such as the Department of Agriculture, Bureau of Animal Industry, and Food and Drug Administration, among others can import meat products into the country.

The Bureau assures the public that it is closely coordinating with the various regulatory agencies of the government in implementing policies such as the importation ban on meat products of the Department of Agriculture.

BOC nabs HAO-SHIAO!

THE Bureau of Customs (BOC) under the stewardship of Customs Commissioner Rey Leonardo B. Guerrero, on 20 May, nabbed a 'HAO-SHIAO' allegedly involved in the "TARA" collection. According to initial reports, the said individual was wearing an expired dilapidated BOC ID valid until 1 March 2019. The suspect was identified as Xavier Daniele J. Gabriel, 19 years old, from Sampaloc, Manila.

Gabriel was arrested after members of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP), currently detailed with the Intelligence Group (IG), found large amount of cash, deposit slips, and four (4) pass books inside his envelope all in the name of Renly Tiñana, alias "Empoy", of the Port of Manila [POM].

According to the Intelligence Division [ID], Gabriel acted as the courier of Mr. Tiñana in delivering cash for bank deposits.

The interception is a testament to the BOC's reform initiatives and continued partnership with the AFP and Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) in ridding the agency of corruption.

It further bolsters the Bureau's commitment to the President's order to stop corruption and other illicit transactions within the Bureau.

BOC clarifies the issue on illegal drugs!

THE Bureau of Customs (BOC) today clarified that what was auctioned off at the Manila International Container Port (MICP) was Tapioca Starch and not Hydrochloride Methamphetamine or commonly known as "Shabu."

The Bureau agrees that the auction of prohibited items is not allowed under Republic Act 10863, otherwise known as the Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA). As far as the BOC is concerned, what was auctioned in April 2019 was Tapioca Starch which is highly perishable in nature.

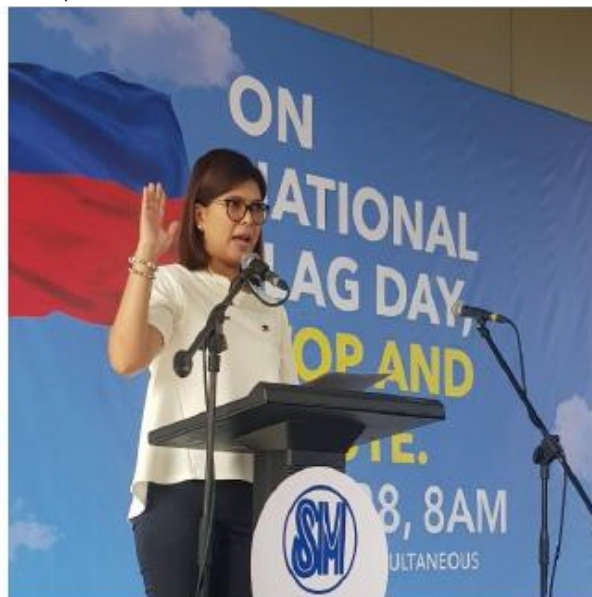
Meanwhile, a thorough investigation is now being conducted on the matter to look into the personalities involved in the importation of illegal drugs.

The Bureau stresses that regarding operations on illegal drugs, it is the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) and not the BOC that acts as the lead agency.

The bureau maintains close coordination with the said agency to ensure the timely and efficient apprehension of illegal drugs as well as the people involved. BOC is now coordinating with the Office of Senator Panfilo Lacson regarding the issues raised in his privileged speech.

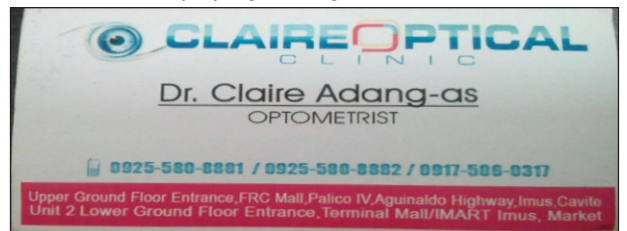

ANGKAS/HABAL2 LEGALIZATION BILL ON SENATE PLENARY SAYS CEBU REP. DEL MAR



Cebu City North District Representative Raul del Mar disclosed yesterday that his House Bill no. 6099 legalizing the motorcycle-for-hire or Angkas and Habal-Habal operations are now for plenary discussion in the Senate. In an exclusive interview by DAILY TRIBUNE, Del Mar disclosed that yesterday the committee report has already been circulated among Senators for signature and eventually for plenary by June 3.

House Bill 6099 authored by Del Mar and co-authored by Cebu City South District Representative Rodrigo Abellanosa has already been passed in the House of Representatives and was transmitted to the Senate Committee on Public Services.

The Bill aims to regulate and legalize motorcycle-for-hire operations and it will authorize cities and municipalities to grant franchise to its operations.

It will amend some provisions in Republic Act 7160 or the Local Government Code and Republic Act 4136 or the Land Transportation Code.

Both Del Mar and Abellanosa insisted that these Angkas and Habal-Habal operations should be legalized as it has been a practical transportation mode among people especially coming from mountain barangays in cities and municipalities. In Cebu alone, Habal-Habal and Angkas operations has reached to more than 18,000 and in Cebu City, more than 7,000.

Del Mar said on June 3, the Senate through the Committee on Public Services will tackle the proposed bill on second reading during the plenary.

Earlier, the Department of Transportation (DOTr) issued a provisional order to allow Angkas and Habal-Habal operations for three months in Metro Manila and Metro Cebu. In Metro Manila, an estimated 35,000 Angkas and Habal-Habal drivers are into the motorcycle-for-hire operations.

CEBU CITY MAYOR-ELECT ED LABELLA PRIORITIZES GARBAGE, FLOODING AND WATER CONSERVATION PROBLEMS AS 41K INFORMAL SETTLERS ARE TO BE RELOCATED

Cebu City Mayor-elect Edgardo Labella said yesterday that his administration will focus on the problems of garbage, flooding, water conservation and the socialized housing to more than 41,000 registered informal settlers in the city. "As I have said over and over again, short term solution for garbage and flooding.

And, of course, I would immediately convene a committee that would look into the water problem especially now that the national government and the provincial government have both manifested their intention to work hand in hand with us solving the water problem in the city," he added.

In a unity meeting on Sunday with Cebu Governor-elect Gwendolyn Garcia and Presidential Assistant for the Visayas Michael Dino, Garcia offered the Aloguinsan landfill in the western part of the province as dumpsite of wastes of Cebu City as its Inayawan landfill has been closed on the Supreme Court ruling. The City of Cebu alone has been collecting wastes and garbages daily that reaches 600 tons.

Presently, the city dumps wastes in the town of Consolacion. Labella disclosed that he is tapping the Central Command (CenCom) of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) to assist in the dredging of the drainage system, rivers and creeks that may ease out floodings in the city.

As this developed, Labella said that socialized housing

projects will be initiated in his incoming administration particularly to at least 41,000 informal settlers in the city. "One of the first things that we will do is to make an inventory of our city-owned lots. In addition to that, we have to look for proper and accessible places for the socialized housing," he said.

Of the 41,000 informal settlers, 10,000 families are living along danger zones like rivers and creeks and in landslide prone areas. He added that the city needs 150 hectares to house these informal settlers and he is considering a lot in Barangay Lorega.

Presidential Assistant for the Visayas Michael Dino, for his part assured that the national government will help the Province and City of Cebu in the construction of socialized housing units. "If the city and the province will provide lots, the national government will put up those socialized houses, I promise you," Dino said. The Office of the Presidential Assistant for the Visayas (OPAV) said the national government aims to provide about 100,000 units of socialized housing for Cebu in the next three years.

"This will alleviate poverty as we will have more productive citizens which will subsequently promote peace and order in these communities. It will also spur economic growth as these projects will bring in more investments and provide more jobs for our people," Dino added.

Both Labella and Dino agreed that that socialized housing units should be decent home not only houses but community. And it should have all the amenities and utilities including electricity and water supply and there is dwelling and prosperity.

METRO CEBU EXPRESSWAY-PHASE 3 TO BE COMPLETED BY MID 2022

The Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) in Central Visayas assured yesterday that the Phase 3 of the Metro Cebu Expressway project will be completed in the middle of 2022 said DPWH-7 Regional Director Edgar Tabacon.

"We chose Phase 3 to be implemented by DPWH through contractors, while Phase 1 and 2 will be offered to either Public-Private Partnership (PPP) or a foreign loan under the Overseas Development Assistance (ODA)," He said.

"Phase 3 with a length of 17 kilometers is now ongoing in Barangay Pangdan (City of Naga) and is being undertaken by QM Construction Corporation, including the acquisition of the right-of-way," Tabacon told reporters.

He explained that because the entire Phase 3 has a cost estimate of P4.4 billion and the P600 million has already been released, the remaining P3.8 billion will be equally appropriated in three General Appropriations Acts, or P1.288 billion each, in 2020, 2021 and 2022.

The Metro Cebu Expressway project has a total length of 73 kilometers from the City of Naga to Danao City in the north. The project is divided into three phases: Phase 1 is from Danao City to Mandaue City; Phase 2 from Mandaue City to Talisay City passing Cebu City's mountain barangays; Phase 3 from Talisay City to Pangdan, City of Naga.

However, Tabacon admitted that with the high cost of acquiring land for the new roads, the P600-million appropriation for the Cebu Expressway has only covered 1.8 kilometers instead of the original 2.5 kilometers.

He cited the land in barangay Pangdan in the City of Naga which were valued at P1,500 per square meter as some landowners were already paid while the others await payments.

Half of the P600 million which were released in two tranches of P300 million each were allotted to road right-of-way acquisition and payment of properties while the remaining balance went to civil works.

Expropriation cases has been filed by the Office of the Solicitation General (OSG) to some property owners affected by the Expressway project, who refuses to sell their properties.

This has delayed the civil works to some portions of the project. But Tabacon said "We want the Phase 3 of the project be completed in the second quarter of 2022 so President Rodrigo Duterte can inaugurate it before his term ends."

MINOR AND UNDERAGE OFW'S STOPPED AT NINOY AQUINO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT FOR FALSIFYING AGE



Two more suspected human trafficking victims were stopped from leaving by immigration officers at the Ninoy Aquino International Airport (NAIA) for falsifying their birthdates.

Bureau of Immigration (BI) Port Operations Division Chief Griffon Medina said the two female passengers, who presented valid overseas Filipino workers (OFWs) documents, were intercepted last Wednesday at the NAIA terminal 1 by members of the Bureau's Travel Control and Enforcement Unit (TCEU).

According to reports, the duo attempted to depart via a Scoot Airways flight to Jeddah, Saudi Arabia allegedly to work as household service workers when they were flagged for secondary inspection by frontline immigration officers.

Medina said the officers doubted the ages of the passengers as indicated in the passports due to inconsistencies in their answers and their demeanor.

It later was later found that one of them is a minor, as she is only 15 years old while her companion is only 20 years old," he revealed. Only those who are 23 years of age and above are qualified for deployment for domestic work in the Middle East.

Glenn Ford Comia, BI-NAIA 1 TCEU head, said both passengers presented valid passports, employment contracts, overseas employment certificates (OECs) and working visas to Saudi Arabia.

Their passports and other documents, although valid, were fraudulent acquired as it contained falsified dates of births," Comia said.

It was learned that the minor passenger, whose year of birth in her passport is 1994, admitted that she was actually born in 2003 while the other passenger, who claimed she was born in 1994, confessed that her real year of birth is 1998.

Comia observed that trafficking syndicates have stopped faking the ages of their victims in the past, especially since the practice was uncovered by BI-NAIA officials last year. "They probably thought we will let our vigilance down after the issue has died down. They are wrong. This is a very serious issue as it involves young women being victimized by these unscrupulous individuals," said Comia.

BI Commissioner Jaime Morente expressed his concern regarding the recent interceptions. "The victims are getting younger and younger," said Morente. "Minors are more vulnerable to be duped by these syndicates, we reiterate our warning to those who want to work abroad—do not fall for these illegal schemes," he added. Morente also urged the other members of the Inter-Agency Council Against Trafficking to pursue cases against the recruiters. "We have to stop these recruiters from victimizing others," he said.

BUREAU OF CUSTOMS CLARIFIES THE ISSUE ON ILLIGAL DRUGS

The Bureau of Customs (BOC) today clarified that what was auctioned off at the Manila International Container Port (MICP) was Tapioca Starch and not Hydrochloride Methamphetamine or commonly known as "Shabu."

The Bureau agrees that the auction of prohibited items is not allowed under Republic Act 10863, otherwise known as the Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA). As far as the BOC is concerned, what was auctioned in April 2019 was Tapioca Starch which is highly perishable in nature.

Meanwhile, a thorough investigation is now being

conducted on the matter to look into the personalities involved in the importation of illegal drugs.

The Bureau stresses that regarding operations on illegal drugs, it is the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) and not the BOC that acts as the lead agency. The bureau maintains close coordination with the said agency to ensure the timely and efficient apprehension of illegal drugs as well as the people involved.

BOC is now coordinating with the Office of Senator Panfilo Lacson regarding the issues raised in his privileged speech.

Ang ipinagtataka ay kung bakit 20% lamang daw mula sa 100 containers na nakakapasok sa bansa ang dumadaan sa X-ray system ng Customs pag-amin Dy Buco.

Kaya siguro nagduda ang mambabatas na posibleng pinalabas lamang ito ng BOC na ire-recycle pero mayroong nakahalang kontrabando sa bundok na basura kasabay ng pagsasabing nagbabatay lamang ang BOC sa idineklarang laman ng shipment.

Kung ating iisipin bakit nga ba kailangan pang mag-import ng basura ang Pilipinas para i-recycle gayung dito sa bansa ay napakaraming basura at hindi nga malaman kung saan itatapon ang mga ito - hindi po ba?

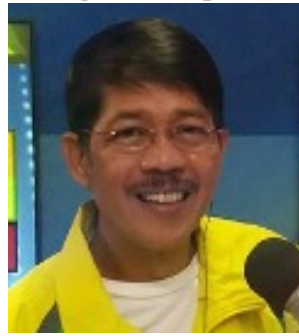
