In commemoration of 121st Philippine Independence Day, Senator Cynthia A. Villar along with Cavite Governor Jesus Crispin C. Remulla, Kawit Municipal Mayor Angelo Emilio G. Aguinaldo and Philippine Navy Rear Admiral Giovanni Bacordo, led the flag-raising at the balcony of the Aguinaldo Shrine in Kawit, Cavite on June 12, 2019 where the historic declaration of the nation's liberty from Spanish Colonization was witnessed in 1898.

Of the 10 Cebuano District Representatives, at least two expressed frustration over reported and alleged vote-buying of Speakership contenders in the House of Representatives.

Representatives Raul del Mar(North District, Cebu City) and Pablo John Garcia(Third District, Cebu Province) told DAILY TRIBUNE that their votes are "not for sale."

"I'll be voting for Rep. Lord Velasco as I believe he'll make a better Speaker among those vying for the position. I will never receive a single centavo, not even a million pesos for my vote.

There are proposals from the Liberal Party and the Visayas bloc that I am a member of to vote as one, but I have already made known to them that I have already committed to vote for Rep. Velasco," Del Mar said.

For his part, Rep. Garcia, said "I have not been offered anything for my vote. I'm not part of the Visayas bloc so I cannot speak for the group. It's too early in the game. The field could broaden, or narrow. A lot could happen in six weeks."

As of the press time, other Cebuano Representatives Rodrigo Abellanosa (South District, Cebu City), Eduardo Gullas (First District, Cebu Province), Wilfredo Caminero (Second District, Cebu Province), Janice Salimbangon (Fourth District, Cebu Province), Duke Frasco (Fifth District, Cebu Province),Emmarie Ouano-Dizon (Sixth District, Cebu Province),Peter John Calderon (Seventh District, Cebu Province) and Paz Radaza (long congressional district, Lapu-Lapu City) were unable to reply on the issue. Earlier, former Speaker and Davao del Norte Representative Pantaleon Alvarez disclosed that there were reports to plan to "buy votes" for the speakership in the House of Representatives which ranges from P500,000 to P1 million per representative.

This according to one of the reelected Representative has even increased to P7 million per representative. The incoming 18th Congress is composed of 270 members of the House of Representatives, including the 54-member Partylist bloc.

There are 95 elected Representatives from the Partido ng Demokratikong Pilipino-Lakas ng Bayan(PDP-Laban); 37 from the Nacionalista Party(NP); 33 from the Nationalist People's Coalition(NPC); 28 from the National Unity Party(NUP); 18 from Liberal Party(LP) and five from Lakas-Christian-Muslim Democrats (CMD).

Vying for the speakership aside from Alvarez are: Leyte Representative Martin Romualdez, Marinduque Representative Allan Velasco, Pampanga Representative Aurelio Gonzales and Taguig Representative Allan Peter Cayetano.

NO TO SPEAKERSHIP PAY-OFF**LABELLA TO FIRE AND HIRE MORE THAN 5K CASUAL/JOB ORDER EMPLOYEES AS HE INVITES PRO-OSMENA COUNCILORS TO HIS FOLD**

Cebu City Mayor-elect Edgardo Labella admitted that there are casual, job order (JO) and barangay workers, who will be terminated effective July 1,2019 as these openly campaigned against him during the last elections.

This as a committee was formed by him to review and evaluate the performance of the City Hall casual and job orders including barangay workers.

While, he has not yet assumed as City Mayor, last May 31 was the last day for job order employees, who were part of the Barangay Mayor's Office(BMO).

"I don't mind if they voted in favor of the opposite side but if they campaign hard and involved in mudslinging and character assassination, of course, these are considered because it is not fair to our supporters," he told media.

"You have to take into consideration that there maybe others who have been active campaigning against our group, our candidates, that should be considered because it is not fair for our supporters that there are those who actively campaigned against us will be renewed while there are supporters who worked so hard for us...even their careers, they risked their opportunities," he added.

"I am a fair man. I am not a vindictive man. That's precisely the reason why I created a committee will be validated by me and other political personalities of the group. We will ask the barangay captains, the officials who are with us," Labella said.

As he assured that he will not follow the outgoing administration that ordered the "sweeping termination" of all allies of the previous administration. There are more than 5,500 casual and job order employees presently hired by the administration of outgoing Mayor Tomas Osmena.

"To be frank about it, those who worked hard against us and even involved in mudslinging and character assassination against our group, then we will take cognizant of their posturing and those demeanor by them because we have to take into consideration that we also have our supporters who worked hard for us," Labella reiterated.

He said " Their sacrifice should not go unnoticed by us. We have to give importance to their help and their sacrifices vis-avis those of instead of just working, even get involved in mudslinging and political activity against us."

As this developed, Labella welcomed Bando Osmena Pundok Kauswagan (BOPK) City Councilors to join the Partido Barug-PDP Laban as he wants an inclusive governance so anyone from the other political fence is welcome to become part of his administration. City Councilor Jerry Guardo, who lost in his reelection bid yesterday told media that he is fully supporting the incoming Labella administration. "This is my personal choice, I will support the incoming Mayor Ed Labella," Guardo added.

The pronouncement of Guardo, will be plus one barangay captain for Labella as Guardo's wife Aileen is the barangay captain of Sambag Uno. Presently, there are 54 of the 80 barangay captains in Cebu City that are supporters of outgoing Mayor Osmena.

The incoming City Council by July 1 has nine councilors with BOPK and seven PDP Laban plus the ex officio councilors from Association of Barangay Councils(ABC) President and Sangguniang Kabataan Federation(SKF) President,who are both with BOPK. Labella's party is the minority bloc.

"Well of course, everybody is welcome... As I've said our system of governance would be inclusive, Inclusive in the sense that we are willing to adopt and embrace everyone who wants to have a better Cebu City," Labella added.

BOC DECENTRALIZES AMO PROCESSES AND SIMPLIFIES ITS ACCREDITATION PROCEDURES!

IN its aim to expedite processing at the Bureau of Customs - Account Management Office (BOC-AMO), the bureau decentralizes its AMO processes and simplifies its accreditation procedures. Customs Memorandum Order (CMO) No. 19-2019 issued on April 16, 2019 by Commissioner Rey Leonardo B. Guerrero allows the renewal of customs brokers' accreditation and the activation of the Client Profile Registration System (CPRS) of entities accredited by other government agencies to be processed at the Collection District nearest to their principal place of business.

The CMO aims to reduce the number of signatories from four to two, instead of having it approved through AMO, Office of the Deputy Commissioner for Intelligence Group and the Office of the Commissioner, now, with the CMO, brokers' accreditation will only be processed at the local Customs Intelligence and Investigation Service (CIIS) and at the office of the District Collector.

The activation of the customs broker's CPRS and the preparation of the Certificate of Accreditation (COA) shall be done by the AMO Head Office. Signed COAs will then be transferred to the District Collectors for release to the customs brokers.

CPRS activation of entities accredited by other government agencies will be done at the Office of the District Collector upon the receipt of endorsement with the attached requirements from concerned government agencies.

This move of the bureau is only part of the various information systems that BOC has introduced in line with the ten-point priority program of Commissioner Guerrero.

Para sa kaalaman ng lahat mga katoto, ang MEPCOM ay isa sa pangunahing sangay ng Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) na siyang nangangasiwa sa kalinisang ng karagatan partikular na kung may mga nagaganap na trahediya ng nagkabanggaan o lumubog na barko na magdudulot ng pagkalat ng langis sa karagatan o oil spill na dapat maagapan upang hindi makapinsala sa yamang dagat ng bansa.

Ayon kay katotong Kumander ng MEPCOM Rear Admiral George V Ursabia Jr.PCG, sa bisa ng isang General Order No. 151 taong Mayo 30, 1998, ang isa sa functional command ng MEPCOM, ang pinalawak na National Operations Center for Oil Pollution (NOCOP) kung saan ang dakilang misyon nito ay mapangalagaan at mapigilan ang polyusion sa karagatan kailugan, at tributaries in order to preserve a healthful and well balance marine resources ng bansa.

Gayon din ang naisyung Administrative Order No.16 ni Pangulong Rodrigo Duterte nitong Pebrero 19, 2019 na palawigin ang rehabilitasyon sa karagatan at marine ecosystem sa Manila Bay at ang pagbubuo ng Manila Bay Task Force ng DENR na pangunahing ahensiya ng 15 departamento ng national government agencies kabilang na ang PCG in compliance MEPCOM and Coast Guard National Capital Region-Central Luzon (CGNCR-CL) kung saan nagsagawa ng 19 na coastal clean-up activities sa lawak na 15 kilometro sa baybaying dagat ng Manila Bay na nakakolekta ng 54,52 tonelada ng basura, samantalang nasa 280 sako ng basura ang

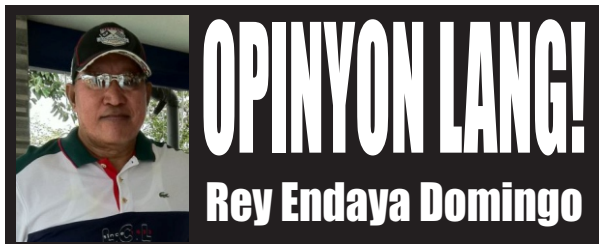

Natimbog kasi nang kanilang pinagsanib na puwersa ang isang pasaherong Indonesian national na naaktuhang may dalang mahigit sa 1.6 kilo ng Cocaine na sinasabing aabot sa P9 na milyong halaga ang street value sa terminal 3 ng paliparan nu'ng nakaraang June 12. Sa kanilang ulat kay Customs Commissioner Rey Leonardo "Jagger" Guerrero, sinabi nina Coll. Talusan at Ray Isais, ang dayuhang pasahero na mabilis rin inaaresto ay kinilalang si Agus Burhan, 62, sakay ng Quatar Airways Flight QR932 na lumapag sa terminal 3 ng NAIA.

Sinasabing nadiskubre ang mga Cocaine sa loob ng "secret compartment" ng mga maletang bitbit ni Burhan. Dating gawi. Dumaan sa epektibong kontra ismagling na X-ray o scanning machines ang naturang mga bagahe kaya nabisto ang nasabing illegal drugs. Bagama't pilit na itinatangi ng suspek na sa kanya ang nasakoteng droga, nakatakda pa rin siyang sampahan ng kaukulang kaso nina Coll. Talusan at Ray Isais dahil sa paglabag sa batas na may kaugnayan sa illegal drugs.

Ikalawa, ang nasa 0.54 kilograms Ecstasy na aabot sa

Ayon kay Tacorda si Wu, na nasa listahan ng red notice ng Interpol ng mga fugitives, ay agad na i-book sa unang flight ng Cathay

Coll. Talusan at Ray Isais strikes again, P9-M Cocaine nasabat!

P1.7 milyong halaga. Nakita ang tintukoy na "party drugs" sa loob ng printer na galing sa Netherlands at naka-consigned kay Christian Chan ng San Juan, City.

Ikatlo, ang 2 shipments ng Marijuana (hemp gummy candies dried leaves na idineklarang "pancake mix and lotion." Mula ang mga ito sa Unites States of America. Naka-consigned kay Steven Marple ng Antique at Betty Lu ng LGC Marketing sa Cagayan de Oro, City. At ikaapat, ang 0.0135 kilograms ng Cocaine na nagmula rin sa Amerika. Deklaradong "Toys" ng consignee na si Jose Maristela ng Makati City. Mabilis rin nai-turn sa Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) ang iligal na mga droga para sa kaukulang pag-iingat at imbentaryo. Naharang rin nina Coll. Talusan at Ray Isais ang 757 piraso na aabot sa P310 libong halagang buhay na Tarantulas o klase ng itinuturing mapanganib na mga gagamba na tinanggag ipuslit sa Central Mail Exchange Center (CMEC), Customs bonded warehouse sa Pasay City noong nakaraang April 3.

Sa kanilang ulat kay Comm. Rey Leonardo "Jagger" Guerrero, sinabi nina Coll. Talusan at Ray Isais, ang naturang smuggled cargo ay kinukunsiderang "endangered wildlife species." Ipinadala ng isang nakilalang Wojciech Pakasz. Naka-consigned kay Jessie Camaro ng Caloocan City. Dumating sa CMEC nitong nakalipas lamang April 1 mula sa Poland.

Ayon pa sa "intelligent and workaholic" Customs officials, ang mga Tarantulas na ito ay lubhang mapanganib dahil may taglay na nakalalason at nakabubulag na kemikal na kapag nakagat ang sinumatang tao ay posibleng maging dahilan ng kanilang pagkabalug o kamatayan. Nadiskubre ang naturang illegal na kargamento sa gift-wrapped kasama ang ilang kahon na oatmeal at cookies nang dumaan ang kinalalagyang mga bagahe sa epektibong anti-smuggling X-ray machines na minamanduhan ng grupo ni Ray Isais na nakadeploy sa CMEC. "Violators of illegal wildlife trading may face imprisonment of one year and one day to two years and a fine of P20,000.00 to P200,000.00 based on R.A. 914 (Wildlife Resources Conservation and Protection Act) and or three years and one day but not more than six years imprisonment or a fine of not more than P300,000.00 under unlawful importation pursuant to RA 10863 (Customs Modernization and Tariff Act)," paglilingaw pa nina Coll. Talusan at Ray Isais.

Base sa datos, simula nu'ng 2018 hanggang sa kasalukuyang taon, tinatayang nasa sa 2,152 wildlife and endangered species na kinabibilangan ng 63 iguanas, chameleons and bearded dragons, 250 geckos, 254 corals, at iba pang kauri na nasabat bago tuluyang kinumpiska at magkakasunod nai-turn over ng tropa nina Coll. Talusan at Ray Isais sa Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR).

Kasama rito ang P4.5 milyong halagang 1,532 mga pagong na Star Tortoise, Redfoot Tortoise, Sulcata Tortoise, at Red-eared Slider species na tangkang ipuslit sa NAIA Terminal noong March 19. Nabisto ang imported na mga pagong pagkaraan na sumalang sa epektibong anti-smuggling na X-ray o scanning machines ang dalang mga bagahe ng isang Pinoy na pasahero galing HongKong.

Pero bago natimbog lahat ang mga ito, matatandaang nasakote ng kampo nina Coll. Talusan at Ray Isais ang 13 botelya na naglalaman ng 650 tablets ephedrine na isang pangunahing sangkap

Pacific pabalik sa Hongkong kung saan siya ay naaresto sa kalaunan ng mga awtoridad ng China.

Ipinagbigay alam agad sa Chinese counterparts interpul tungkol sa interception, sa chinese fugitive at pinasakay ito sa eroplano para makabalik ng sarili nilang bansa.

Iniuulat din ni Tacorda na si WU ay sangkot sa isang iligal na operasyon sa negosyo, at may warrant of arrest na inilabas ang Public Security Bureau sa Shenzhen, Shantou, China.

Sinabi ni Tacorda na, kung napatunayang nagkasala, nahaharap ang chinese fugitive sa pinakamaraming parusa at 15 taon na pagkabilanggo dahil sa mga iligal na aktibidad sa negosyo.

Napag-alaman na si Wu ay nasa listahan ng red notice ng Interpol ng mga wanted foreign fugitives mula noong Agosto ng nakaraang taon. Ang BI ay mayroon database ng mga dayuhan na may mga record sa interpul kaya agad itong napansin o natutukoy ng dumating sa bansa.

Ibinahagi ni Tacorda na ang database ay patuloy na nag-update na real-time dahil ito at iniugnay sa network ng National Central Bureau ng Interpol sa Maynila.

Sabi ni TACORDA ang mga opisyal ng imigrasyon ay agad na haharain ang mga dayuhan dahil sa pag-access sa database ng Interpol, at kapag ng swipe sa aming mga scanner sa pasaporte ay agad na mahaharang ang dayuhan na papasok sa bansa na may kaso.

Kasama sa CMO, ang accreditation ng mga broker at mapoproseso lamang sa Customs Intelligence and Investigation Service at sa tanggapan ng District Collector.

Ang pag-activate ng CPRS ng customs broker at paghahanda ng Certificate of Accreditation ay dapat gawin ng account management office head office. pagkatapos ay maililipat ang mga naka-sign na COA sa Mga District Collector at para ipagkakaloob sa mga customs broker.

Ang pag-activate din ng CPRS ng mga entity na kinikilala ng ibang mga ahensiya ng gobyerno ay gagawin sa tanggapan ng Distrito Collector sa pagtanggap ng pag-endorso na kalakip ang mga kinakailangan mula sa mga ahensiya ng gobyerno.

Ang bagong customs memorandum order ng bureau ay bahagi lamang ng iba't ibang mga sistema ng BOC kasama ang programang prayoridad na ten-point agenda ni Custom Commissioner Guerrero.

DUQUE DAPAT MAGBITIW SA PUWESTO

NILINAW ni Senator Panfilo "Ping" Lacson na hindi nito pinasisibak si Health Secretary Francisco Duque III kaugnay ng naturang usapin bagkus aniya dapat itong kusang magbitiw sa puwesto.

Aalamin din nila sa PhilHealth ang iba pang posibleng whistleblower kaugnay ng pagpapatuloy ng naturang imbestigasyon laban sa iba pang dialysis treatment establishment sa bansa.

Nadiskubre na aabot sa P154-B ang pondong nasayang nang maibayad ito sa nasabing bogus dialysis treatment claims. "Hopefully, the NBI can get the assistance of the new PhilHealth management team," dagdag ni Guevarra.

Nakalabas ng kulungan si Sy makaraang nagpiyansa kaugnay ng kinakaharap na kasong estafa at falsification of public documents kaya pinalaya na sa NBI nang pagagan ito ng Manila Regional Trial Court (RTC) na magpiyansa para sa pansamantalang kalayaan nito.

Samantala siniguro ng isang kongresista na iimbestigahan ng Kongreso ang usaping ito ayon kay Camiguin Lone District Rep. Xavier Jesus Romualdo at hihintayin na lamang nila ang pagbubukas ng 18th Congress at ang pagbubuo ng mga komite para tuluyan nang masimulan ang imbestigasyon.

Ngayon hintayin po natin ang sinasabi ng Malakanyang na gagawa daw ng kaukulang hakbang si Pangulong Rodrigo Duterte kaugnay sa nasabing insidente.

Napapansin ng publiko ang pananahimik ng pangulo sa isyung ito na sakay ng nasabing fishing boat ang nasabing mga Pinoy nang banggain ito ng barkong ng China bago sila tuluyang abandonahin sa karagatan.

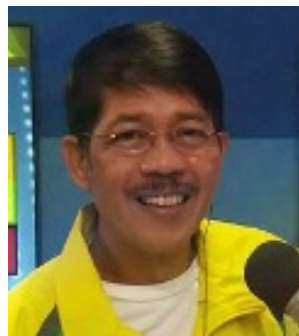

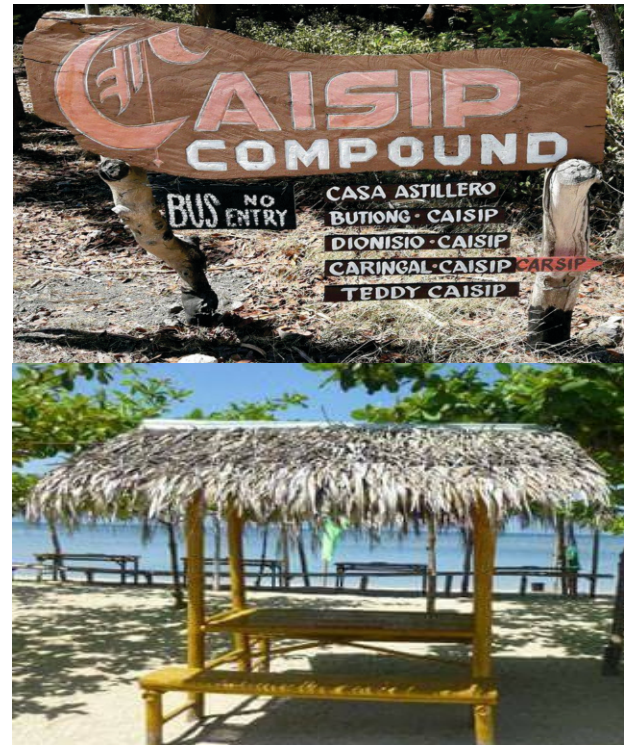
